


# US 81/US 287 at CR 4227/CR 4228 Intersection Improvements and Roadway Reconstruction Project Wise County, Texas

Fort Worth District



## PROJECT OVERVIEW

**Highway/Limits:** 0.6 miles north of CR 4228 to 1.8 miles south of CR 4228

**Project ID:** 0013-08-130

**Project Length:** Approximately 2.4 miles long

**Description:** Ultimately, the proposed project will include reconstruction of US 81/US 287 – taking it from a four-lane rural highway to a four-lane, controlled access highway. A grade separated crossing will be constructed at NRS Ranch Road. In addition to the grade separated crossing, separate mainlanes will be reconstructed and frontage roads constructed, new ramps will be built, and improvements will be made to intersections. U-turns added on frontage roads. An interim project is proposed which will include implementing crossover improvements and adding acceleration/deceleration lanes

**Construction Cost:** The current estimated construction cost is \$39.5 million.

**Right of Way:** The project's current design improvements would require approximately 0.6 acres of Right of Way. Further preliminary design efforts would determine how much additional Right of Way and/or easements are required.
