Development along Hiram Clarke and West Fuqua are not included as part of the proposed Airport Boulevard project. No development information for Hiram Clarke or West Fuqua is available at this time.</p>
3	Gregory Taylor	04-06-17	Comment Form	<p>"My concern is a safety wall along Airport where the backyards meet Airport."</p>	<p>Retaining walls are used to support soils so that the soil can be held at different levels within the right-of-way. To accommodate the placement of, for example, sidewalks, retaining walls will be located in specific areas along Airport Boulevard within the project limits. Retaining walls will be less than 4 feet in height.</p> <p>Based on the TxDOT <i>Guidelines for Analysis and Abatement of Roadway Traffic Noise</i>, noise walls were not determined to be feasible or reasonable within the project limits. A noise abatement measure, such as noise walls, is limited by topography, access requirements for driveways, local cross streets/intersections, drainage, utilities, maintenance and noise reduction. A noise abatement measure is not feasible unless the measure achieves a noise reduction of at least 5 dB(A) at greater than 50% of the first row of impacted receivers (i.e., residences). A determination of reasonableness for noise abatement measures includes the following range of factors: cost effectiveness and noise reduction design goals. To determine cost effectiveness, the estimated cost of constructing a noise barrier is divided among the number of benefitted receivers (those who would receive a reduction of at least 5dB(A)). A cost of \$25,000 or less per benefitted receiver is considered to be "cost effective." When noise abatement measures are considered, the desired noise reduction is determined from calculating the difference between future traffic noise levels at a receiver with noise abatement compared to that noise receiver without noise abatement; this is the noise design goal. TxDOT has defined the noise reduction design goal as achieving a reduction in noise that is at least</p>

					<p>7dB(A). At least one first row receiver must achieve the noise reduction design goal.</p> <p>Aside from retaining walls at selected locations, no walls are planned within the project limits. Noise walls were not determined to be reasonable or feasible within the Airport Boulevard project limits.</p>

Landmark Street is not included as part of the proposed Airport Boulevard project. No development information for Landmark Street is available at this time.

Watson	04-06-17	Comment Form	"Will traffic lights be erected at Glenwyck and West Airport to allow residents to enter and exit Brentwood Subdivision considering the increase in traffic that will be expected?" Also, West Airport at Taintor?	A designated left-turn bay (eastbound and westbound) is proposed at the Airport Boulevard intersection with Glenwyck/Delsanto Street. Turning bays safely remove turning traffic from the through-traffic lanes. Turning bays are not proposed at Taintor Street. TxDOT routinely identifies locations in which traffic signals would benefit motorists. To justify a traffic signal at an intersection, traffic conditions must meet at least one of eight minimum standards known as "warrants." The <i>Texas Manual on Uniform Traffic Control Devices</i> specifies these warrants, which are based on guidelines set by the Federal Highway Administration and TxDOT. Traffic signal considerations include, for example: the amount of traffic on the street, pedestrian activity, number of school children crossing the roadway, crash history at the site, delays to existing traffic flow, speed of traffic approaching the intersection, and size of the community. No traffic signals are currently proposed for the intersection of Airport Boulevard with Glenwyck/Delsanto Street or Taintor Street.

We are so happy that it's finally going through. Well, the question I have is did they take into consideration the thickness of the walls in the house and the construction of the house as it impacts the sound that people inside the house experience. If they didn't and or if they do consider that, then if we still don't qualify for a sound barrier, then would they consider trees on both sides to buffer any potential sound and to consider the additional cars that go through and cause pollution and because my understanding is that trees absorb a lot of pollution that will be impacting our area and our potential health. So that's my comment. Thank you."</p>	<p>A Traffic Noise Analysis Technical Report was completed for the Airport Boulevard project from Hiram Clarke Road to FM 521. A computer model known as the Traffic Noise Model® (TNM®) was used to evaluate the noise generated from the existing and proposed traffic along Airport Boulevard. TNM® takes into consideration Noise Abatement Criteria established by the Federal Highway Administration for residential outdoor activity areas (i.e., backyard for residences or common area/playground in apartments) as well as the interiors of auditoriums, places of worship, schools, etc. The TNM® does not take into consideration building materials of houses. Please see Comment 3 for additional noise information.</p> <p>Trees and other landscaping within the ROW will be planted according to the Landscaping Plan prepared by TxDOT for the project. The Landscaping Plan is available for review at the TxDOT Houston District office. The Landscaping Plan follows the TxDOT <i>Landscape and Aesthetics Design Manual</i> (dated September 1, 2015).</p>

The Environmental Assessment prepared for the Airport Boulevard project has evaluated Community Impacts by reviewing the following items as these items pertain to this project: Existing Conditions, Permanent/Temporary Changes in Access and Travel, Environmental Justice (race, ethnicity, income and poverty), Limited English Proficiency, Regional Economy and Employment, Population Trends, Community Cohesion, and Public Facilities.</p> <p>A Community Impacts Analysis was conducted and approved for the proposed project. Below is a summary of the results. The proposed project would not have any anticipated environmental consequences or disproportionately high and adverse effects on minority populations and is consistent with Executive Order 12898 regarding environmental justice.</p> <p>According to the Census Data, Limited English Proficiency (LEP) populations are present within the Census Tracts inclusive of the project limits. All efforts have been and will continue to be made to ensure that LEP Spanish speakers have the opportunity to fully and fairly participate in the public involvement process.</p> <p>The proposed project would not have any anticipated environmental consequences on the LEP population throughout the project limits.</p> <p>The proposed project would have a positive impact on the local and/or regional economies and unemployment rate in the short-term due to construction of the proposed project, construction workers eating at local restaurants, etc. The proposed project would provide a west-east thoroughfare in a highly populated area of Houston and would upgrade the traffic flow and mobility of the traveling public within the project limits. Neither positive nor negative long-term economic impacts within the project limits are anticipated from the implementation of the proposed project. The increase in travel lanes may eventually contribute to commercial development within the undeveloped, wooded tracts adjacent to the proposed project. Increased safety and mobility for businesses and residents along the Airport Boulevard project limits and beyond are the goals of the proposed project; long-term economic growth is not a goal, but may reflect a secondary outcome from the implementation of the proposed project.</p>

Adding capacity, reducing congestion and improving safety within the Airport Boulevard project limits would reduce the traffic impact of the growing population and would support any associated development in the local area surrounding the proposed project.</p> <p>The Build Alternative would not have any anticipated environmental consequences on the population growth trends surrounding the project limits.</p> <p>The approved Community Impact Analysis can be viewed by request at the TxDOT-Houston District.</p>



Esta notificación informa al público que la Evaluación Ambiental Preliminar (EA) está disponible para la revisión pública y que el TxDOT llevará a cabo una audiencia pública sobre el proyecto propuesto. La Ciudad de Houston, y el Condado de Harris en conjunto con el Departamento de Transporte de Texas (TxDOT) proponen mejoras a la calle Airport Boulevard desde la Hiram Clarke Road hasta la FM 521 en el Condado de Harris, Texas. La audiencia pública se llevará a cabo en 6 de abril, 2017 en la Escuela James Madison High School, 13719 White Heather Drive, Houston, Texas 77045. Las exhibiciones estarán disponibles para ser vistas a las 5:30 pm con la audiencia formal comenzando a las 6:30 pm. El propósito de la audiencia es presentar las mejoras propuestas y recibir comentarios del público sobre el proyecto propuesto.

TxDOT propone ampliar y extender la Airport Boulevard a una distancia de 2.5 millas desde la Hiram Clarke Road hasta la FM 521 en el suroeste de Houston. El proyecto propuesto conectaría la calle existente y proporcionaría un bulevar continuo de 4 carriles con medianas elevadas, carriles para bicicletas y aceras peatonales. TxDOT posee el derecho de vía (ROW) que oscila entre 100-120 pies de ancho para el proyecto propuesto, sin embargo aproximadamente 7 acres de ROW adicionales serían necesarios para construir estanques de retención. No habrá desplazamientos de estructuras residenciales o comerciales. Información sobre el proceso de adquisición de ROW y folletos informativos de asistencia para la reubicación estarán disponibles en la audiencia.

El proyecto propuesto cambiaría el acceso a lo largo de algunas calles residenciales en la subdivisión de Glen Iris. El proyecto dividiría la calle Woodkerr, Lightstar Drive y Ambrose Street. Las calles Woodkerr y Ambrose (al norte de la propuesta Airport Boulevard) harían modificaciones a una calle sin salida/cul-de-sac. Se propone una nueva alineación de la calle para conectar la Lightstar Drive y la Ambrose Street (al sur del proyecto Airport Boulevard).



This notice advises the public that a draft Environmental Assessment (EA) is available for public review and that TxDOT will be conducting a public hearing on the proposed project. The City of Houston, Harris County, and the Texas Department of Transportation (TxDOT) are proposing improvements to Airport Boulevard from Hiram Clarke Road to FM 521 in Harris County, Texas. The public hearing will be held on April 6, 2017, at James Madison High School, 13719 White Heather Drive, Houston, Texas 77045. Displays will be available for viewing at 5:30 p.m. with the formal hearing starting at 6:30 p.m. The purpose of the hearing is to present the planned improvements and to receive public comment on the proposed project.

TxDOT proposes to widen and extend Airport Boulevard from Hiram Clarke Road to FM 521, a distance of approximately 2.5 miles, in southwest Houston. The proposed project would connect the existing roadway segments and provide a continuous 4-lane Boulevard with raised medians, bicycle lanes and pedestrian sidewalks. TxDOT owns right-of-way (ROW) which ranges from 100-120 feet in width for the proposed Airport Boulevard project. Approximately 7 acres of additional ROW would be required for detention areas though no residential or non-residential structures would be displaced. Information regarding the ROW acquisition process and copies of the Relocation Assistance Booklet will be available at the hearing.

The proposed project would change access along residential streets in the Glen Iris subdivision. The project would bisect Woodkerr Street, Lightstar Drive and Ambrose Street. Woodkerr Street and Ambrose Street (north of proposed Airport Boulevard) would have modified cul-de-sac designs. A new roadway alignment is proposed to connect Lightstar Drive and Ambrose Street (south of proposed Airport Boulevard).

The draft EA and related project information are on file and available for inspection by appointment Monday through Friday between the hours of 8:00 a.m. and 5:00 p.m. at the TxDOT Houston District Office, 7600 Washington Avenue, Houston, Texas 77007, at the TxDOT Fort Bend County Area Office, 4235 SH 36 S., Rosenberg, Texas 77471, (281) 238-7900, or at:

11 proposes to widen and extend Airport Boulevard from
12 Hiram Clarke to FM521, a distance of approximately
13 2.5 miles. The project is located in southwest Houston.
14 The project will connect the existing roadway segments
15 and provide a continuous four-lane boulevard with raised
16 medians, bike lanes and pedestrian sidewalks within the
17 proposed limits. TxDOT owns right-of-way which ranges
18 from 100 feet to 120 feet in width for the proposed
19 Airport Boulevard project. Approximately 7 to 10 acres
20 of additional right-of-way would be required for the
21 detention areas though no residential or nonresidential
22 structures would be displaced.

23 With two hands is pretty tricky. The slide
24 show -- excuse me, the slide shows the proposed roadway
25 alignment. A larger project schematic is also

1 available -- was available in the viewing area of the
2 cafeteria.

3 Next slide. These photographs show the
4 roadway conditions along the existing two segments of
5 Airport Boulevard. The proposed project would connect
6 the two existing roadway segments of Airport Boulevard
7 from Hiram Clarke Road to FM521.

8 The current estimated construction bid opening
9 date will be in the Fall of 2017. The current
10 anticipated construction start date will be in the Fall
11 of 2017. Construction is expected to last approximately
12 two years. The current estimated construction cost is
13 \$25.5 million and will be funded by TxDOT and the
14 federal government.

15 Due to the population density in southwest
16 Houston and the limited west-east roadways near the
17 proposed project area, reduced mobility and increased
18 traffic congestion has occurred. There are two existing
19 Airport Boulevard roadway segments within the project
20 limits. The connection of these two segments and the
21 development of a continuous four-lane boulevard from
22 Hiram Clarke Road to FM521 is needed to improve
23 traffic -- local traffic flow, efficiency and safety
24 within the project area.

25 The purpose of the Airport Boulevard roadway

1 improvement project is to connect the existing sections
2 of Airport Boulevard between Hiram Clarke and FM521.

3 The proposed project would offer the traveling public a
4 west-east alternative to the limited existing west-east
5 travel corridors in southwest Houston, which would
6 improve traffic movement and safety in this area of
7 southwest Houston. The project purpose would be
8 accomplished by adding traffic lanes, bike lanes,
9 pedestrian sidewalks and raised median which would have
10 dedicated left turn lanes at selected intersections.

11 The scope of this project includes
12 constructing a four-lane, divided boulevard which
13 corrects the two existing sections of Airport Boulevard
14 and provides a continuous roadway between Hiram Clarke
15 Road and FM521. The travel lanes would be 11 to 12 feet
16 wide with a grassy median separating the eastbound and
17 westbound traffic. Left turn lanes would be constructed
18 at selected intersections and traffic signals would be
19 added if deemed necessary by TxDOT. A 6-foot wide bike
20 lane on the outside of the eastbound and westbound
21 travel lanes would be added. A 5-foot wide pedestrian
22 sidewalk would be installed along both sides of Airport
23 Boulevard. Additionally, two bridge structures would be
24 located at each of the Harris County Flood Control
25 District channel crossings, so a total of four

1 structures would be constructed within the project
2 limits.

3 TxDOT owns all right-of-way necessary to
4 construct the proposed roadway facility at this time.
5 TxDOT would acquire approximately 7 to 10 acres of
6 right-of-way to accommodate detention areas associated
7 with the proposed project. No anticipated residential
8 or commercial displacement would result from the
9 implementation of the proposed project.

10 Utility coordination is ongoing. Public
11 utility adjustments may include gas lines, power lines,
12 fiberoptic cable lines and pipelines.

13 I would like to introduce Ms. Barbara Castille
14 from S&B Infrastructure, our Environmental Project
15 Manager, to walk you through the environmental reviews
16 of the project. Barbara.

17 MS. BARBARA CASTILLE: Thank you, Alexine. As
18 part of the alternative solutions evaluated to meet the
19 development needs of a west-east roadway located in
20 southwest Houston, a No Build Alternative and Build
21 Alternative were studied. The No Build Alternative
22 would not meet the needs of the proposed project as the
23 existing conditions within the project limits would not
24 change.

25 The Build Alternative was additionally

1 evaluated. This alternative would connect Airport
2 Boulevard within the project limits and allow for
3 improvements to local traffic congestion and safety. A
4 roadway corridor is available to allow for the
5 development of a continuous four-lane boulevard between
6 Hiram Clarke Road and FM521.

7 Based on existing data and field
8 investigations, a constraints map for the project
9 corridor was prepared. A copy of this map is also
10 available in the cafeteria for your review.

11 The environmental considerations evaluated as
12 part of the environmental review are shown on this
13 slide.

14 Several technical reports were prepared for
15 this project. Each technical report addressed specific
16 environmental topics. The technical reports were
17 summarized in the approved Draft Environmental
18 Assessment, which is also available for review in the
19 cafeteria.

20 As you can see, the environmental work for
21 this project began in the Fall of 2015. The initial
22 draft environmental assessment document was prepared and
23 submitted to TxDOT for review in December 2016. After
24 this public hearing, all comments received tonight as
25 well as written comments received during the comment

1 period, will be included in the official public hearing
2 record and will be addressed in the final environmental
3 document review. We anticipate the final environmental
4 assessment and environmental decision in the Spring of
5 this year.

6 All related technical reports are available
7 for public review at the TxDOT Houston District Office.
8 In addition, should you wish to obtain a copy for your
9 personal use, paper copies may be purchased from TxDOT
10 for the cost of reproduction.

11 Once the environmental review is finalized,
12 TxDOT will begin to acquire right-of-way, relocate
13 utilities and complete the final design. Construction
14 is anticipated to begin in the Fall of 2017.

15 At this time, I would like to hand the hearing
16 back to Christine Bergren.

17 MS. CHRISTINE BERGREN: Thank you, Barbara.
18 Now, we will begin the public comment session of the
19 hearing. There are several ways to comment on the
20 proposed Airport improvement project. You can give your
21 verbal comments when I open the floor for public comment
22 or you may submit your comments in writing. If you
23 would like to make verbal comments at tonight's hearing
24 but you did not complete a speaker registration card,
25 please raise your hand and you will be given a speaker

1 card to complete.

2 If you submit your comments in writing, it is
3 not necessary to repeat your comments verbally. Written
4 and verbal comments will be considered equally. I
5 introduced several elected official representatives and
6 elected officials; however, I do not indicate that any
7 of y'all wish to speak tonight. Do I have any elected
8 officials or the representatives that would like to make
9 a verbal comment tonight?

10 DONALD PERKINS: Good evening, I'm Donald
11 Perkins, chief of staff of councilman Green's office and
12 I just want to say that we are very supportive of this
13 project. We are so happy that it's finally going
14 through. It's been an up-road battle with the council
15 member with getting the right funding for it and so we
16 really want to let it be known that as soon as the
17 project starts for construction, which probably will be
18 in the Fall of 2017, we're going to hold some
19 informational meeting similar to this. We're going to
20 invite the TxDOT project manager to come, as well as the
21 construction crews, so you guys know who's coming on
22 board, we find out what the timeframe will be and
23 phases. Particularly, those neighborhoods that's most
24 affected by Brentwood Village, Villas of Brentwood,
25 Brentwood Place, Angel Lane, those are the communities

1 that really affect this project overall. So that's my
2 public comment. Thank you.

3 MS. CHRISTINE BERGREN: And now, I would like
4 to provide an opportunity for those who have registered
5 to speak on the proposed project. You will have three
6 minutes to make your comments and when I announce your
7 name, please come to the microphone, which I will hand
8 you and clearly state your name and who you may
9 represent. A timer located on the screen will indicate
10 the beginning of your three minutes and after three
11 minutes, you will be asked to be seated so the next
12 speaker can make his or her comments. If you have
13 additional comments, please provide the written comment
14 form provided to you.

15 Now, I will call the speakers listed on the
16 speaker registration card in the number they will be
17 seen. I only have one individual who's indicated that
18 they would like to speak and that is Aundra Fusilier, if
19 I have -- close enough. So if you would, take the
20 microphone here, please again state your name, who you
21 represent.

22 AUNDR A FUSILIER: My name is Aundra Fusilier
23 and I'm a resident of Brentwood Place, homeowners'
24 association. And the question I have is related to
25 the -- the sound barrier, a potential sound barrier. Is

1 there an engineer here to answer any technical
2 questions?

3 MS. CHRISTINE BERGREN: During the formal
4 public comment session we do not answer questions but
5 you are -- please make that comment and we can get with
6 you after this.

7 AUNDRA FUSILIER: Okay. Well, the question I
8 have is did they take into consideration the thickness
9 of the walls in the house and the construction of the
10 house as it impacts the sound that people inside the
11 house experience. If they didn't and -- or if they do
12 consider that, then if we still don't qualify for a
13 sound barrier, then would they consider trees on both
14 sides to -- to buffer any potential sound and to
15 consider the additional cars that go through and cause
16 pollution and -- because in the -- my understanding is
17 that trees absorb a lot of the pollution that will be
18 impacting our -- our area and our potential health. So
19 that -- that's my comment. Okay.

20 MS. CHRISTINE BERGREN: Thank you, sir. Do we
21 have anybody else wishing to make a comment? For anyone
22 who would like to submit written comments, there are
23 comment forms attached to your handout packet and at the
24 sign-in table. We have provided a comment box if you
25 choose to leave your completed form tonight or you may





Secondly the existing wood fence will not be able to take the impact of a vehicle in case of an accident. This presents a safety hazard to the residents living close to the roadway.





Hiram Clarke Road to 575' East of Blue Cromis Lane




Townwood Drive to 150' East of Ambrose Street




Proposed Typical Section








Proposed Typical Section








