



Notice of Public Meeting FM 1098: US 290 to Owens Road Landscaped Median and Left-turn Lanes

Prairie View A&M University in cooperation with the Texas Department of Transportation (TxDOT), Houston District, will hold a Public Meeting regarding the proposed raised landscaped median and left-turn lanes along Farm to Market (FM) 1098 from US 290 to Owens Road in Waller County, Texas. The meeting will be held Tuesday, June 20, 2017, at the Prairie View A&M University Willie A. Tempton Sr. Memorial Student Center, Ballroom B, 155 L.W. Minor Street, Prairie View, Texas 77446. The meeting will be held in an open house format from 4:00 p.m. to 7:30 p.m. No formal presentation will be made.

The purpose of the proposed project would be to improve safety; reduce the number of traffic accidents; provide access management within the project area; and to aesthetically enhance the entrance to the Prairie View A&M University campus (to be consistent with the Campus Master Plan). The total project length is approximately 0.5 miles.

Maps showing the proposed project's location and design drawings will be available for review at the Public Meeting. This information will also be available by appointment for review Monday through Friday between the hours of 8:00 a.m. and 5:00 p.m., excluding state holidays, at the Prairie View A&M University Main Campus, FM 1098 and University Drive, Prairie View, Texas 77446.
