The Texas Department of Transportation (TxDOT) will hold a public meeting on Tuesday, September 25, 2018, from 5:30 p.m. to 7:30 p.m. to solicit input on proposed recommendations to improve State Highway (SH) 3 from Brookglen Drive to the Harris/Galveston County line. The meeting will take place at the City of Webster Civic Center, 311 Pennsylvania Avenue, Webster, TX 77598. The meeting will be held in an open house format where the public may come and go at their convenience and provide comments at any point. Staff will be available to answer questions; no formal presentation is planned.

The study has identified short-, medium-, and long-term improvements to reduce crashes, improve mobility, and support existing and future development, all based on comments received from the public. This meeting provides opportunities to learn about these proposed improvements, ask questions, and provide feedback.

Maps of the study corridor and exhibits will be available at the public meeting.
