The Lovely Rubies clothing store is now open for business at 1001 N. Pecos, formerly the State Farm offices of agent Kessia Ledesma.

Owner Sirenia Sanchez is excited about launching her new fashion venture and explains why she feels her Lovely Rubies boutique will be treasured by the community.

"I opened Lovely Rubies for the girls and women who have a low self-esteem," said Sanchez. "I had a low self-esteem myself. When I'd go shopping, I always felt like all the clothing was made for only one body type. That's why I wanted

to open a store that carries a variety of fashionable clothes in all sizes."

The first day of business for Lovely Rubies was Saturday, Sept. 15 with Sanchez providing her first batch of customers with a spread of sandwiches, finger foods and refreshments.

Sanchez hired local artist Indian Frank to create a hand-painted sign for her building, which the artist installed last week giving the fashion outlet its finishing touch.



FM 1776 AT FM 1450 PROJECT LOCATION MAP


