# Proposed Project Description


- New main lanes (2 westbound, 2 eastbound)
- Access ramps (2 entrance, 2 exit)
- Overpass at CR 1140
  - Turn lanes
  - U-turns
  - Sidewalks
- Removal of existing crossovers
  - CR 1135
  - Crossing to west of CR 1140
- Other improvements
  - Rehab frontage road pavement
  - Drainage, lighting, signs, pavement markings






# Traffic Access Routes - Loop 250 at CR 1135
