Proposed Project on State Loop (SL) 250 at County Road (CR) 1150 and CR 60 CSJ: 1188-02-087

The Odessa District of the Texas Department of Transportation (TxDOT) has scheduled a public meeting for a proposed project on SL 250 at CR 1150 and CR 60 in Midland County, Texas. The public meeting is scheduled for:

The purpose of the meeting is to provide information about the proposed project and gather input from the public. Maps of the project area and other displays will be available for review and comment. TxDOT staff will be available to answer questions. The meeting will consist of an Open House from 5 p.m. to 6 p.m., followed by a brief presentation at 6 p.m., and a question-and-answer session.

The Odessa District of TxDOT proposes to construct a segment of the SL 250 corridor, including ramps, main lanes, and overpasses at the intersections of CR 1150 and CR 60. The proposed improvements are located in north Midland County, as shown.
