



NOTICE OF VIRTUAL PUBLIC MEETING
Proposed FM Spur 121 (Grayson Parkway) near Gunter, Texas – Grayson County
From County Rd 60 (CR 60) To Farm to Market Road 121 (FM 121)

The Texas Department of Transportation (TxDOT), Paris District, with support from the Grayson County Regional Mobility Authority (GCRMA), is proposing to construct a new location roadway from CR 60 to FM 121 in Grayson County, Texas, referred to as the FM Spur 121 (Grayson Parkway). **This notice advises the public that TxDOT will be conducting an online virtual public meeting on the proposed project.** The virtual public meeting will begin on Tuesday, July 28, 2020 at 5 p.m. The virtual meeting will consist of a pre-recorded video presentation explaining the proposed project, which includes both audio and visual components, along with other exhibits and materials for the public to review. The virtual public meeting materials will be posted at: www.txdot.gov keyword search “FM Spur 121” on July 28, 2020 at 5 p.m. and will remain available online through the comment period deadline of August 12, 2020. If you do not have internet access, you may call the TxDOT project manager, Duane Good, P.E., at (903) 737-9282 to ask questions about the project and access project materials at any time during the project development process. Formal comments may be provided by electronic survey, mail, or email as explained below.

The purpose of the FM Spur 121 (Grayson Parkway) project is to improve safety, increase regional mobility, and improve connectivity. The project will construct a new location, two-lane, undivided state roadway from CR 60 (near the Denton/Grayson County line), north to FM 121 (west of the City of Gunter), a distance of approximately 4.5 miles. Maps showing the project location and design, and other information regarding the proposed project will be available online at the website listed above.

The proposed project would, subject to final design considerations, require right-of-way with no residential or commercial displacements. Information about the tentative schedule for right-of-way acquisition and construction, can be obtained from the TxDOT district office by calling (903) 737-9300. TxDOT is currently conducting environmental studies to determine the effects of proposed new location roadway on the community and natural environment. Environmental documents will be available for public review prior to project completion.

TxDOT makes every reasonable effort to accommodate the needs of the public. The virtual public meeting will be in English. If you have special communication or accommodation needs, such as the need for an interpreter, please contact the TxDOT Paris District Public Information Office at (903) 737-9213 at least two working days prior to the virtual meeting. Please be aware that advance notice is requested as some accommodations may require time for TxDOT to arrange.
