



The Paris District of the Texas Department of Transportation (TxDOT) will hold a Transportation Improvement Program (RTIP) meeting on Monday, May 7, 2018, from 4:00 pm until 7:00 pm. Written comments will be accepted during this open house public meeting in the Ballroom of the Paris Junior College McLemore Student Center, in Paris, Texas.

Department representatives will be on hand to discuss the Paris District's Project Development Plan and Schedule for Transportation Projects in fiscal years 2019 through 2022. TxDOT's Paris District consists of Delta, Fannin, Franklin, Grayson, Hopkins, Hunt, Lamar, Rains, and Red River Counties. TxDOT officials will accept comments from the public regarding the plan and give the public the opportunity to comment on any other transportation projects.

All interested citizens are invited to attend the meeting. However, attendance at the meeting is not required for comment consideration. Written comments will also be accepted for an additional twelve (14) days following the meeting. The address for written comments is:
