


PROJECT FACT SHEET

US 82 (Clarksville Loop) Project

From BU 82/SH 37 Junction to FM 412



PROJECT DETAILS

CSJ: 0045-11-042

Limits: From the Business US 82/SH 37 Junction to FM 412 in the City of Clarksville and Red River County

Project Length: 4.4 miles

Description: The existing US 82 facility is a two-lane rural highway with one 12-foot-wide travel lane in each direction. The proposed project would widen US 82 to a four-lane, divided rural highway with two 12-foot-wide travel lanes in each direction. Other proposed improvements include reconstruction of interchanges, ramps and bridges, in addition to sidewalk, trail and drainage improvements. Schedule and funding for construction has not been identified for this project.

US 82 (West of Clarksville) Project: Schematic design for improvements to US 82 (West of Clarksville) from West Division Street in Blossom to SH 37 in Clarksville is also underway.

US 82 (East of Clarksville) Project: Schematic design for improvements to US 82 (East of Clarksville) from US Business 82-J in Clarksville to CR 3310 is also underway.
