Project Length: 16 miles


Schedule and funding for construction have been identified for this project.

PROPOSED IMPROVEMENTS

The proposed improvements to US 82 include the following:

- Widen US 82 from a two-lane highway to a four-lane divided highway for a distance of approximately 16 miles
- Design roadway with two 12-foot-wide travel lanes in each direction, a 10-foot-wide outside shoulder, and a 68-foot-wide depressed median or a 16-foot-wide two-way left turn lane
- Provide a five-foot-wide sidewalk would be provided at the edge of the right of way on both sides within the City of Paris limits
