



# Notice of Virtual Public Meeting

## FM 2061 (South McColl Road) from SH 107 to Trenton Road

The Texas Department of Transportation (TxDOT) is proposing to improve FM 2061 (South McColl Road) from SH 107 to Trenton Road in Hidalgo County, Texas. This notice advises the public that TxDOT will be holding an online virtual public meeting on the proposed project. The virtual meeting will be held beginning on Tuesday, May 26, 2020 at 6 p.m. To log on to the virtual public meeting, go to the following web address at the date and time indicated above: [www.txdot.gov](http://www.txdot.gov). Type the keyword, "FM 2061 Public Meeting" into the search box on the top right of the webpage. You may also use the QR code included with this notice. Project staff will give a pre-recorded presentation regarding the project with both audio and visual components.

The virtual public meeting will remain available online through the comment period deadline of June 10, 2020.

If you do not have internet access, you may call the TxDOT Project Manager, Samantha Lozano, P.E. at 956-702-6334 to ask questions about the project and access project materials at any time during the project development process. Formal comments may be provided by mail, email, or voicemail as explained below.

The purpose of the project is to enhance safety and mobility along the project corridor. Proposed improvements include constructing a raised median with left-turn lanes at intersections and constructing continuous sidewalks along FM 2061 (South McColl Road) from SH 107 to Trenton Road, a distance of approximately 2.8 miles. The project will require additional right of way to accommodate U-turns. Although additional right of way would be required, no residential or non-residential structures are anticipated to be displaced at this time. Information concerning services and benefits available to affected property owners and information about the tentative schedule for right of way acquisition and construction can be obtained from TxDOT district office by calling 956-702-6100.

Any environmental documentation or studies, maps and drawings showing the project location and design, and other information regarding the proposed project are available online at the web address noted above.

TxDOT makes every reasonable effort to accommodate the needs of the public. The virtual public meeting will be available in English and Spanish. If you have a special communication accommodation or need for an interpreter, a request can be made.
