Project Purpose and Need

What problems are we trying to address?

- Lack of mobility along FM 676
- Lack of pedestrian accommodations
- Inadequate drainage

What are we trying to do?

- Add capacity
- Improve safety
- Increase mobility
- Drainage improvements



Project Details

Project Limits

- From: SH 364 (La Homa Rd.)
- To: SH 107 (Conway Ave.)

Project Scope

- Widen existing roadway to four lane curb and gutter urban arterial facility with a two-way left turn lane
- Improve intersection operations by adding turn lanes
- Provide 5-foot sidewalks and ADA ramps on both sides
- Provide underground storm drain system and drainage outfalls

- From SH 364 (La Homa Rd.) to SH 107 (Conway Ave.)
- Total Length: 2.5 miles






Existing FM 676 (SH 364 to SH 107)
