




# OLD ALICE ROAD IMPROVEMENT PROJECT

### Project Overview

Cameron County, in conjunction with the Cameron County Regional Mobility Authority and the Texas Department of Transportation (TxDOT), is proposing to reconstruct and widen the existing two-lane rural roadway to a four-lane urban divided roadway with shoulders and sidewalks within the cities of Los Fresnos and Brownsville Cameron County Texas from the Sports Park Boulevard to SH 100, a distance of 4.9 miles.

As the area has grown, this travel corridor has seen an increase in development along the roadway. The roadways existing conditions do not meet the existing and projected traffic demands of the area. Due to this increase in traffic the proposed improvements will improve mobility, reduce traffic congestion and improve safety.



- 4-lane urban roadway
  - 10-foot shoulders
  - Curb and gutter storm water system
  - 12-foot travel lanes
  - 16-foot left-turn lane
  - 8-foot sidewalks on both sides of roadway
  - Reconstruct and widen the existing bridge

\$18.1 million
