US 281 – PUBLIC MEETING

The Texas Department of Transportation (TxDOT) Pharr District will host a public meeting to present the proposed improvements for US 281 in Hidalgo County and Brooks County. The project limits on US 281 are from SH 186/FM1017 to FM 3066. It is planned to construct 4 lanes divided (2 main lanes each direction) and 2 lane frontage roads in the interim. The ultimate section would add an additional 2 main lanes (1 lane each direction) to be constructed as traffic warrants in the future. The proposed project will improve mobility and safety. The purpose of these public meetings is to present the proposed design and gather public input. The public is invited to view project maps and a presentation, visit with TxDOT staff, ask questions, and share comments on the proposed project improvements.
