



## **Public Meeting Notice – 2017-2019 San Antonio Proposed Revisions to Rural Transportation**

### **Improvement Plan: I-10 from North Creek Road to US 87**

The Texas Department of Transportation will conduct a public meeting on March 15, 2018 from 5:00 – 6:30 at the TxDOT District Office at 4615 NW Loop 410, Building 2, San Antonio, TX 78229. The purpose of this meeting is to allow public input regarding a revision to the 2017-2019 Rural Transportation Improvement Plan (RTIP). This revision is to include a single mobility project on I-10 from North Creek Road to US 87 in Kendall County. This project will complete east bound and west bound frontage roads and convert to one way operation, reconfigure ramps and intersection operational improvements. The RTIP is a mechanism used by TxDOT and FHWA to fund projects for the next four years and includes all federally funded projects. The meeting will be held in an open house format where the public may come and go at their convenience. Staff will be available to answer questions and there will be no formal presentation.
