

FM 1535 Project Limits


From Loop 1604 to Shavano Ranch Road

Improvements Include


- Expanding from 2 to 4 lanes with a center-turn lane and raised median
- Adding sidewalks and bicycle accommodations




Existing Configuration

FM 1535 Expansion Project Construction

- Funded by TxDOT and Alamo Area Metropolitan Planning Organization
- Estimated cost \$5.6 million




Other Projects

NW Military Highway Improvement Project (from Huebner Road to Loop 1604): TxDOT is planning for improvements including adding a center-turn lane, sidewalks, and bicycle accommodations. An open house will be held in summer 2018.

Loop 1604 Turnaround: TxDOT is constructing a turnaround lane on Loop 1604 at NW Military Highway (FM 1535) for eastbound traffic to U-turn to travel westbound. Construction is anticipated to begin in late 2018 and take approximately six months.
