

YOU'RE INVITED TO AN OPEN HOUSE FOR THE PROPOSED FM 471 PROJECT




The Texas Department of Transportation (TxDOT) is hosting an open house to present proposed improvements to Farm-to-Market Road (FM) 471 (Culebra Road) from State Highway (SH) 211 to Old FM 471, a total distance of approximately 3 miles in Bexar and Medina counties, Texas. The proposed FM 471 project would include the following improvements:

- Widen FM 471 from a 2-lane roadway to a 4-lane roadway with raised medians
- Bike and pedestrian accommodations
- An overpass at SH 211 over FM 471, to connect to the proposed SH 211 extension south of FM 471 (project managed by Bexar County)
