



**Notice
Final Environmental Assessment
and Finding of No Significant Impact
Available for Public Review**

I-10

From FM 3351 (Ralph Fair) to La Cantera Parkway

This notice advises the public that a final environmental assessment (EA) is available for public review and the Texas Department of Transportation (TxDOT) has issued a finding of no significant impact (FONSI) for the proposed I-10 expansion project from FM 3351 (Ralph Fair Road) to La Cantera Parkway in Bexar County, Texas. The environmental review, consultation, and other actions required by applicable Federal environmental laws for this project are being, or have been, carried-out by TxDOT pursuant to 23 U.S.C. 327 and a Memorandum of Understanding dated December 16, 2014, and executed by FHWA and TxDOT.

The proposed I-10 expansion project would expand I-10 from four main lanes to eight main lanes by adding one general purpose main lane and one high occupancy vehicle (HOV) lane each way between FM 3351 (Ralph Fair Road) and La Cantera Parkway, approximately 5.9 miles. The purpose of the project is to improve mobility along the I-10 corridor in this rapidly growing area. The project would be constructed within the existing state owned right of way (ROW) which has a minimum width of 300 feet.

To avoid noise impacts that may result from future development adjacent to a proposed highway project, a traffic noise analysis is included in the final EA, which includes predicted noise impact contours for currently undeveloped areas. These impact contours are intended as a general guide to assist local planning officials and developers plan and construct new activities in locations that would not result in traffic noise impacts. On the date of approval/clearance of an EA/FONSI (including the traffic noise analysis) for a proposed highway project, TxDOT is no longer responsible for providing noise abatement for new development.
