




- 2013-2017 AADT traffic volumes from TxDOT Count Map (I-10 mainlanes and frontage road AADT, north of FM 3351)
- 2024-2054 traffic volumes based on linear projections





(each direction)





- What is an HOV lane?
 - An HOV lane, or carpool lane, is a special lane reserved for:
 - Carpools
 - Vanpools
 - Buses
 - Motorcycles
 - Emergency response vehicles
 - These special lanes enable those who carpool or ride the bus to bypass traffic in the adjacent, unrestricted general purpose lanes. Lanes are identified as "2+" or "3+" which refers to the minimum number of occupants to qualify.



HOV Lane Benefits:

- Reduction in Congestion
- Increase in Ridership/
Vanpools/Mass Transit Service
- Moving More People
- Improvement to Safety
- Establishment of Corridor
Reliability
- Long-Term Mobility Choice



Evaluated Potential Impacts:



- **Community**
No displacements;
minimal changes in travel
patterns and access
- **Biological**
No impacts to threatened
or endangered species
- **Waters**
Impacts to two waters of
the United States Army
Corps of Engineers
(USACE)
- **Edwards Aquifer**
Portion of project in
Bexar County lies over
the Contributing and
Recharge Zones and
would require an
Edwards Aquifer
Protection Plan; water
treatment controls would
be in place to meet Texas
Commission on
Environmental Quality
(TCEQ) standards; no
impacts anticipated



Evaluated Potential Impacts:



- Historic – no impacts to historic resources anticipated
- Archeological – previously disturbed; low potential for impacts
- Noise – 14 receivers impacted; abatement measures examined but not found to be feasible and reasonable; no abatement is proposed

Additional Considerations

- Acquisition of additional right-of-way is not anticipated

Environmental documentation is available for review




Projected Construction Schedule
