From State Highway (SH) 16 to Ingram Road

Bexar County, Texas

The Texas Department of Transportation (TxDOT) is proposing to improve I-410 from State Highway (SH) 16 to Ingram Road, a distance of approximately 14.9 miles in San Antonio, Bexar County, Texas. Pursuant to Texas Administrative Code, Title 43, Part 1, Chapter 2, Subchapter E, §2.107 and §2.108 and Code of Federal Regulations, Title 23, Chapter I, Subchapter H, §771.111 and Title 40, Chapter V, §1506, this notice advises the public that environmental tech reports are available for public review and that TxDOT will be conducting a public hearing on the proposed project on **Tuesday, March 5, 2019** at **Northside Activity Center** located at **7001 Culebra Road, San Antonio, Texas 78238**. Project schematics and displays will be available for viewing at 5:00 p.m. with the public hearing starting at 6:00 p.m. The purpose of the hearing is to present the planned improvements and to receive public comment on the proposed project.

The proposed project includes upgrading ramps and direct connectors at the I-410/I-35 interchange, constructing additional travel lanes and widening existing travel lanes, constructing new bridges, widening existing frontage roads, and providing bike and pedestrian accommodations. The purpose of the project is to improve mobility and safety and improve connections between I-35 and I-410.

The existing right-of-way (ROW) varies from 300 feet to 400 feet wide. Proposed ROW will vary between 300 feet and 500 feet along the length of the project. Approximately 25.19 acres of additional ROW would be required for the proposed improvements. Although additional ROW is required, no residential or non-residential displacements would occur. Information concerning services and benefits available to affected property owners about the tentative schedule for ROW acquisition may be obtained from the District Office at the address listed below.

Environmental documents or studies, maps showing the project location and design, project schedule, and other information regarding the project are available for viewing Monday through Friday between the hours of 8:00 a.m. and 5:00 p.m. at the TxDOT San Antonio District Office, 4615 NW Loop 410, San Antonio, TX 78229. This information will also be available for inspection at the hearing. Verbal and written comments from the public regarding the project are requested and may be presented at the hearing, or submitted in person or by mail to HNTB, Attn: Cynthia Coss, RE: I-410 SW, 9601 McAllister Freeway, Suite 1001, San Antonio, TX 78216 or emailed to ccoss@hntb.com.

Written comments must be postmarked on or before **Wednesday, March 20, 2019** to be part of the official hearing record.

The hearing will be conducted in English.
