Loop 1604: From US 281 to FM 1303



The Texas Department of Transportation (TxDOT), in funding partnership with the Alamo Regional Mobility Authority (ARMA), will host an open house on Thursday, April 27, 2017, to present proposed improvements to Loop 1604 from US 281 to FM 1303. The proposed project would expand Loop 1604 from a 2-lane to a 4-lane divided roadway with shoulders and pedestrian accommodations at various locations. The purpose of the proposed project is to reduce congestion and improve operational efficiency and safety of LP 1604 between US 281 and FM 1303.

Open House

Anyone interested in the project, is invited to attend the open house public meeting. There will be no formal presentation, so attendees can come and go at their convenience. Attendees will have the opportunity to view schematics of the proposed improvements, visit with team members, ask questions and share their comments on the project.


