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

**Notice Affording An Opportunity

Bexar County, Texas**

The Texas Department of Transportation (TxDOT) is proposing to widen Loop 1604 from US 281 to FM 1303 in Bexar County, Texas. The total distance of the project is approximately 8.1 miles. Pursuant to Texas Administrative Code, Title 43, §2.106 this notice is affording an opportunity for a public hearing on the proposed project.

The proposed project would expand the current 2-lane roadway to a 4-lane divided roadway with shoulders and pedestrian accommodations where appropriate. The interchange at Loop 1604 and US 281 would be upgraded to a diamond interchange including elevated Loop 1604 eastbound and westbound lanes over US 281 with entrance/exit ramps and traffic signals on US 281. Turnarounds would be provided at various locations along the project. Construction limits would extend approximately 0.74 mile west of US 281 to Rockport Road and 0.28 mile east of FM 1303 in order to transition back to the 2-lane section. The proposed project would include two 12-foot lanes in each direction separated by a grassy median with 4-foot inside shoulders and 10-foot outside shoulders within the existing 220-foot Right-of-Way (ROW), therefore no additional ROW is required for the proposed project.

Potential jurisdictional waters of the U.S. were identified within the ROW of the proposed project. All unavoidable impacts to jurisdictional waters of the U.S., including wetlands, would require a Section 404 Permit with the US Army Corps of Engineers. Although, portions of the project are located within the 100-year floodplain, it would not increase the base flood elevation to a level that would violate applicable floodplain regulations.

Environmental studies and documentation, maps showing the project location and design, and other information regarding the project are on file and available for inspection Monday through Friday between the hours of 8:00 a.m. and 5:00 p.m. at the TxDOT San Antonio District Office, 4615 NW Loop 410, San Antonio, TX 78229. El Departamento de Transporte de Texas (TxDOT) está proponiendo la expansión de Loop 1604 desde la carretera US 281 hasta la calle de granja-al-mercado (FM 1303) en el condado de Bexar. La distancia total del proyecto es aproximadamente 8.1 millas. En conformidad con el Código Administrativo de Texas, Título 43, §2.106, este aviso brinda la oportunidad de una audiencia pública sobre el proyecto propuesto.

El proyecto propuesto expandiría la carretera actual de 2 carriles a una carretera dividida de 4 carriles con banquetas y acomodaciones peatonales en lugares apropiados. El intercambio de Loop 1604 y US 281 se actualizaría a un intercambio de diamante incluyendo el carril Loop 1604 elevado hacia el este y el oeste sobre el US 281 con rampas de entrada/salida y señales de tráfico en el US 281. Giras de vuelta serán proporcionadas en varias locales a lo largo del proyecto. Los límites de construcción se extenderían aproximadamente 0.74 millas al oeste de US 281 a Rockport Road y 0.28 millas al este de FM 1303 con el fin de la transición, de regresar a la sección de 2 carriles. El proyecto propuesto incluiría dos carriles de 12 pies en cada dirección separados por una mediana divisoria de la carretera con banquetas interiores de 4 pies y banquetas exteriores de 10 pies adentro del derecho de vía de 220 pies existente del estado (ROW), por lo tanto, el proyecto propuesto no requiere derecho de vía adicional.

Se identificaron aguas jurisdiccionales potenciales de los EE.UU. a dentro del derecho de vía del proyecto propuesto. Todos los impactos inevitables a las aguas jurisdiccionales de los EE. UU., incluidos los humedales, requerirían un Permiso de la Sección 404 con el Cuerpo de Ingenieros del Ejército de EE. UU. Aunque se encuentran partes del proyecto dentro de la llanura aluvial de 100 años, no aumentaría la elevación base de la inundación a un nivel que violaría las regulaciones aplicables de la llanura de inundación.




