The South Abbott road is being used as a thoroughfare from Hwy 87 to Loop 1604 and that too will triple or quadruple once East Central is completed because it's the closest route from the High School to the new Elementary, or from the area of the High School & Middle School to the New Elementary, therefore you are looking at the possibility of 5,000 vehicles/day utilizing that tiny road</p>	<p>The scope of this proposed project focuses on Loop 1604 and will not address Abbott Rd at this time. The City of San Antonio 2018 Major Thoroughfare Plan identifies Rakowitz Rd (Abbott Rd) to eventually be a Secondary Arterial between US 87 and Loop 1604.</p>
				<p>There are no shoulders for vehicles heading south on Loop 1604 turning right onto south Abbott Road, but you have a turning lane when heading North on Loop 1604 to turn left on South Abbott Road. When heading north on Loop 1604 sitting in the turn lane, waiting to turn left on to South Abbott road you are a "sitting duck" for the vehicles heading south on Loop 1604 who tries to pass around the vehicles turning right on South Abbott Road.</p>	<p>The proposed design would have Loop 1604 transition back to a two lane divided roadway at Abbott Road. As part of the transition, the southbound lanes of Loop 1604 at FM 1346 would include a dedicated right turn lane, dedicated left turn lane and a lane that would continue straight on Loop 1604.</p>
				<p>There is an accident at least twice a week at the South Abbott and Loop 1604 intersection because of this design and because of the number of traffic utilizing this thoroughfare. There is no way to look up the statistics at this intersection because law enforcement put Loop 1604 and FM 1346 on their reports which is common because it is the nearest largest intersection and I know this because I am a law enforcement officer.</p>	<p>The proposed design includes a southbound dedicated right turn lane, dedicated left turn lane and a lane that would continue straight on Loop 1604 at Abbott Road. The addition of the dedicated turn lanes will improve safety at the intersection. In addition, improvements to Loop 1604 are planned to be extended south of Abbott under a separate project.</p>

Abbott Rd is currently being used as a thoroughfare and being utilized by many individuals and school buses. This thoroughfare is a direct (the only fastest direct) route from Hwy 87 to Loop 1604. East Central High School is currently located near Hwy 87. East Central has a school opening on FM 1346 and FM 1518 in 2019 which will cause this thoroughfare to quadruple in traffic. The school (elementary) opening soon is already at full capacity of 1,100 students and East Central is already looking for more land for another school. East Central has purchased the property located between Abbott Rd and FM 1346 on 1604. Which from Abbott Road thoroughfare to FM 1346 on 1604 is approx. 1200 feet. A solution would be extend 1604's 4 lane past Abbott Rd heading south.</p>	<p>At this time, the proposed project would focus on expanding Loop 1604 from I-10 East to FM 1346. However, Loop 1604 is planned to be expanded south to US 87 in future projects.</p>
				<p>My concern would be the safety issues at Abbott Road and Loop 1604. The four-lane does not come that far. There is no lights. There is no anything other than traffic and a stop sign. 

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

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Militares en la frontera

En la localidad fronteriza de Roma, Texas, se pudo ver el martes de la semana pasada a alrededor de media docena de miembros uniformados de la Guardia Nacional cerca de uno de los puentes internacionales, mientras del otro lado del Río Grande o Bravo, había niños jugando.

No quedó claro si esos integrantes de la Guardia Nacional eran nuevos o forman parte de las misiones previas de observación y reporte en la frontera de Texas con México.

Trump indicó la semana anterior que quiere enviar entre 2.000 y 4.000 miembros de la Guardia Nacional a la frontera, y emitió una proclama en la que señala como causa "el desgobierno que persiste en nuestra frontera sur".

Funcionarios del gobierno de Trump han dicho que el creciente número de personas detenidas cruzando la frontera sur del país requiere una respuesta inmediata, a pesar de que encajan en las tendencias de temporada de los últimos años.

Las detenciones continúan estando muy por debajo de las tendencias históricas de los gobiernos de los expresidentes George W. Bush y Barack Obama, quienes también desplegaron a la Guardia Nacional en la frontera.

Algunos de los miembros de la Guardia Nacional portarán armas y serán enviados a lugares potencialmente peligrosos, dijo Abbott, quien añadió que quería restar importancia a la especulación de que "nuestra

Guardia Nacional se presentará con bayonetas militares e intentando ir detrás de todo aquel que cruce la frontera, porque ese no es su papel".

No hay una fecha para poner fin al despliegue, resaltó Abbott. "Esto es algo que puede llevar mucho tiempo".

Trump ha dicho que quiere utilizar al ejército en la frontera hasta que haya progreso en el proyecto de muro fronterizo que propuso en la campaña presidencial, el cual ha quedado prácticamente estancado en el Congreso.

El secretario de Relaciones Exteriores de México, Luis Videgaray, dijo, por su parte, que su país está ahora reevaluando su cooperación con Estados Unidos.

Mr. Anderson;

I write to you regarding the TxDot project Loop 1604 from 1-10 to FM 1346.

I own the property on the corner of 1604 and Abbott road on the North West corner. I also live near and my best friend lives at the corner of 1604 and Abbott road on the South West corner. If you were standing at the intersection of FM136 and Loop 1604 on the South West corner you will see a fence line that goes up FM1346 and ends at Abbott road well that is my property.

What you may not know is that East Central High School has purchased that corner intersection and is now adjacent to my property. I know this because East Central spoke with me about purchasing my corner too. East Central plans to start building on at intersection at FM1346 and loop 1604 as soon as the school they are building on FM1346 and FM1516 is complete.

*While I am **not opposing the expansion**, I have some great concerns.

The concern would be the intersection at loop 1604 and South Abbott Road. I checked with TxDot and according to Texas Department of Transportation's 2015 Urban Traffic Map there are 736 vehicles/day on South Abbott Road. 10,206 vehicles/day on Loop 1604 and South Abbott Road. 1,642 vehicles/day on FM1346 travelling to and from Loop 1604

The number of vehicles on FM1346 to and from Loop 1604 will triple if not quadruple when East Central has completed their new Elementary at the end of 2018. The South Abbott road is being used as a through-fare from Hwy 87 to Loop 1604 and that too will triple or quadruple once East Central is completed because it's the closest route from the High School to the new Elementary, or from the area of the High School & Middle School to the New Elementary, therefore you are looking at the possibility of 5,000 vehicles/day utilizing that tiny road.

*Here is the problem with the intersection of South Abbott Road and Loop 1604 which is just a couple hundred feet from Loop 1604 & FM 1346 intersection.

There are no shoulders for vehicles heading south on Loop 1604 turning right onto south Abbott Road, but you have a turning lane when heading North on Loop 1604 to turn left on South Abbott Road. When heading North on Loop 1604 sitting in the turn lane, waiting to turn left on to South Abbott road you are a "sitting duck" for the vehicles heading South on Loop 1604 who tries to pass around the vehicles turning right on South Abbott Road.

There is an accident at least twice a week at the South Abbott and Loop 1604 intersection because of this design and because the number of traffic utilizing this through-fare. There is no way to look up the statistics at this intersection because law enforcement put Loop 1604 and Fm1346 on their reports, which is common because it is the nearest largest intersection and I know this because I am a Law Enforcement Office.

Living in the area residents hate to turn down the road at Loop 1604 and Texas Pride Bar-B-que because the intersection is not only on a curve but its on a hill as well.

I gave you the problems and I would like to make a suggestion to help solve the problem. I feel if you were extending the widening of Loop 1604 further south to Hwy 87 it would stop and congestion from "bottle-necking" especially after East Central High School's new Elementary is completed. And even more so after their new school on the corner of Loop 1604 and FM 1346 is completed.

I ask that you please look into the concerns now; please go to the South Abbott and Loop 1604 intersection to see what I am speaking about. Please also drive down South Abbott road to Hwy 87 to see how south Abbott road is being used as a through-fare.

As a result of comments that were made at the Open House, northbound acceleration lanes at Schuwirth Road and at FM 1346 were added to the proposed design. Additionally, some private driveways along Loop 1604 were either relocated or added to accommodate residents in the area.
