



## NOTICE OF OPEN HOUSE SH 16 - Old San Antonio Road to Robindale East Road

The Texas Department of Transportation (TxDOT) will host an open house on Tuesday, November 14, 2017, to present proposed improvements to State Highway 16 (SH 16) from Old San Antonio Road to Robindale East Road in Bandera County. The proposed project will expand SH 16 to two travel lanes each way, add a continuous center turn lane, and add bicycle and pedestrian accommodations.

Anyone interested in the project is invited to attend the open house public meeting. There will be no formal presentation, so attendees can come and go at their convenience. Attendees will have the opportunity to view schematics of the proposed improvements, visit with team members, ask questions and share their comments on the project.


