



Notice of Open House  
Wurzbach Parkway from Lockhill-Selma Road to NW Military Highway

The Texas Department of Transportation (TxDOT) will host an Open House about proposed transportation improvements along an approximately 1-mile section of Wurzbach Parkway from Lockhill-Selma Road to NW Military Highway in San Antonio, Bexar County, Texas. The Open House will be held on Tuesday, February 28, 2017 from 5:00 p.m. to 7:00 p.m. at Oak Meadow Elementary School Cafeteria located at 2800 Hunters Green Street, San Antonio, TX 78231. The Open House will be an opportunity for the public to comment on the proposed improvements.

Proposed improvements include constructing a Wurzbach Parkway underpass bridge at NW Military, uninterrupted eastbound and westbound lanes on Wurzbach Parkway under NW Military and ramps from eastbound and westbound lanes on Wurzbach Parkway to NW Military. Also included in the proposed improvements are bike and pedestrian accommodations and new traffic signals for Wurzbach Parkway ramp intersections.

All interested citizens are encouraged to attend the Open House to view information on the proposed improvements, provide comments, and ask questions. The Open House format allows for members of the public to come and go at their convenience and there will be no formal presentation.
