From US 87 to US 277

The Texas Department of Transportation (TxDOT) is proposing to reconstruct and upgrade FM 2105 from US 87 to US 277 in Tom Green County, Texas. The San Angelo TxDOT District will hold the second public meeting regarding this project to discuss construction impacts on traffic and travel patterns including a proposed short-term detour on Grape Creek Road. The meeting will take place on Thursday August 1st, 2019, at the Northridge Baptist Church Fellowship Hall, 2447 W. FM 2105, San Angelo, Texas, 76901. The meeting will be held in an open house format from 6:00 PM to 7:30 PM, with a presentation at 6:30 PM.

As it is currently designed the proposed project will reconstruct FM 2105 within the project limits to improve pavements and increase shoulders from 8 feet in width to 10 feet in width. The proposed project also includes the addition of a 14 foot center turn lane from US 87 to SH 208 and the addition of a culvert on the north side of FM 2105 and Grape Creek Road. Any environmental documentation or studies, maps showing the project location and design, tentative construction schedules, and other information regarding the project are on file and available for inspection Monday through Friday between the hours of 8:00 a.m. and 5:00 p.m. at 4502 Knickerbocker Road, San Angelo, Texas, 76904. Additionally, responses to comments received will similarly be on file and available for inspection once they have been prepared.

You may submit questions or comments covering the social, economic and environmental effects of the proposed location and design for this project. Comments must be received in writing on or before August 7th, 2019 to be included in the public meeting record.
