LEGAL NOTICE OF PUBLIC MEETING FOR FM 2493

The Texas Department of Transportation (TxDOT) will conduct a public meeting on Tuesday, March 7, 2017, to present the updated plans for the proposed widening of FM 2493 from FM 346 in Flint to US 69 in Bullard.

The project information will be presented in a come and go format with no formal presentation being made. Meeting details are as follows:

The purpose of the meeting is to gather additional public input on the proposed improvements from FM 346 in Flint to US 69 in Bullard. Proposed work includes widening the existing two-lane pavement structure to four lanes with a flush median. This project will require purchasing new right-of-way from adjacent property owners.

All interested parties are invited to attend this meeting to gather information and provide feedback. Every reasonable effort will be made to accommodate those needs.
