LEGAL NOTICE OF PUBLIC MEETING

Texas Department of Transportation (TxDOT) will hold a public meeting on **Tuesday, April 23, 2019**, to present the proposed widening of Old Jacksonville Highway (FM 2493) in the City of Tyler. The meeting will be from **5 to 7 p.m. at Harvey Hall Convention Center** located at 2000 West Front Street, Tyler. The meeting will be an open house, “come-and-go” format without a formal presentation. Representatives from TxDOT and its consultants will be available to answer individual questions.

The purpose of the meeting is to gather public input on various alignment alternatives. The project’s limits are from Loblolly Lane/Woodland Hills Drive, south to Saline Creek Road/FM 2813. The proposed work includes widening the existing four lanes with a continuous center turn lane to a six-lane roadway with a raised median. The project will require new right-of-way from the adjacent property owners.

All interested parties are invited to attend this meeting, gather information, and provide feedback. Persons with special communication or accommodation needs, including language interpretation, should contact TxDOT at (903) 510-9100 at least two working days prior to the meeting. Every reasonable effort will be made to accommodate your needs.

Written comments related to the proposed project may be submitted at the meeting or mailed to Texas Department of Transportation, Advanced Project Development Office, 2709 West Front Street, Tyler, Texas, 75702. Comments may also be emailed to FM2493@txdot.gov. To be included as part of the project’s official record, comments must be received by Tuesday, May 7, 2019.
