LEGAL NOTICE OF PUBLIC MEETING

Texas Department of Transportation (TxDOT) will hold a public meeting on Thursday, March 7, 2019, to present proposed roadway improvements for FM 2964 (Rhones Quarter Road) in Smith County. The meeting will be held from 5-7 p.m. at Brown Elementary cafeteria located at 14600 County Road 2191, Whitehouse, TX 75791. The meeting will be an open house, “come-and-go” format without a formal presentation. Representatives from TxDOT and its consultants will be available to answer individual questions.

The purpose of the meeting is to gather public input on three alignment alternatives. The projects’ limits are from SH 110, south to FM 346 in Whitehouse. The proposed work includes widening the existing two-lane facility to four lanes with a continuous left turn lane with bike and pedestrian facilities. The project will require new right-of-way from adjacent property owners.

All interested parties are invited to attend this meeting, gather information, and provide feedback. Persons with special communication or accommodation needs, including language interpretation, should contact TxDOT at (903) 510-9100 at least two working days prior to the meeting. Every reasonable effort will be made to accommodate those needs.

Written comments related to the proposed project may be submitted at the meeting or mailed to Texas Department of Transportation, Advanced Project Development Office, 2709 West Front Street, Tyler, Texas, 75702. Comments may also be emailed to Chelsea.McLeod@txdot.gov. To be included as part of the project’s official record, comments must be received by Friday, March 22, 2019.
