The Texas Department of Transportation (TxDOT) will conduct an open house meeting on Thursday, May 17, 2018, to present the proposed 2019-2022 Rural Transportation Improvement Program (TIP). The meeting will be held from 4 - 6 p.m. at TxDOT's Tyler District Office, 2709 West Front Street, Tyler, Texas 75702.

The Rural TIP is a listing of federally funded projects that will be constructed or implemented over the next four years throughout the district's eight county area of Anderson, Cherokee, Gregg, Henderson, Rusk, Smith, Van Zandt and Wood counties. Maps and project listings will be available for review at the open house.

All interested parties are invited to attend this meeting to gather information and provide feedback.
