LEGAL NOTICE OF PUBLIC MEETINGS

The Texas Department of Transportation (TxDOT) will conduct two public meetings to present the proposed roadway improvements for SH 31 in Smith and Gregg Counties. The first meeting will be held Tuesday, November 14, 2017, from 5-7 p.m. at Highland Park Baptist Church located at 2424 S. Henderson Blvd, Kilgore, TX 75662. The second meeting will be held Thursday, November 16, 2017, from 5-7 p.m. at Harvey Convention Center located at 2000 West Front St., Tyler, Tx. 75702. All interested citizens are encouraged to attend one of the meetings. **The information presented at each meeting is identical, so it is not necessary to attend both meetings. It will be an open house “come and go” format with no formal presentation.** Representatives from TxDOT and its consultants will be available to answer individual questions.

The purpose of the meeting is to gather public input on the three alignment alternatives. The project's limits are from Loop 323 in Tyler, east to FM 1639 in Kilgore. The proposed work includes widening the existing two-lane pavement structure to four lanes with a flush and/or depressed median. The project will require new right-of-way from adjacent property owners.

All interested parties are invited to attend this meeting, gather information, and provide feedback. Persons with special communication or accommodation needs, including language interpreters, should contact TxDOT at (903) 510-9100 at least two working days prior to the meeting. Every reasonable effort will be made to accommodate those needs.

Written comments related to the proposed project may be submitted at the meeting or mailed to the Texas Department of Transportation, Advanced Project Development Office, 2709 W. Front Street, Tyler, Texas, 75702. Comments may also be emailed to carson.hollis@txdot.gov. To be included as part of the project's official record, comments must be received by Friday, December 1, 2017.
