LEGAL NOTICE OF PUBLIC MEETING

The Texas Department of Transportation (TxDOT) will conduct a public meeting on Thursday, November 2, 2017, to present the proposed roadway improvements for SH 42 in Gregg County. The meeting will be held from 5-7 p.m. at White Oak ISD Food Service Center located at 200 S. White Oak Rd, White Oak, Texas 75693. It will be an open house “come and go” format with no formal presentation. Representatives from TxDOT and its consultants will be available to answer individual questions.

The purpose of the meeting is to gather public input on the three alignment alternatives. The project’s limits are from US 80 in White Oak south to IH 20. The proposed work includes widening the existing two-lane pavement structure to four lanes with a flush median. The project will require new right-of-way from adjacent property owners.

All interested parties are invited to attend this meeting, gather information, and provide feedback. Persons with special communication or accommodation needs, including language interpreters, should contact TxDOT at (903) 510-9100 at least two working days prior to the meeting. Every reasonable effort will be made to accommodate those needs.

Written comments related to the proposed project may be submitted at the meeting or mailed to the Texas Department of Transportation, Advanced Project Development Office, 2709 W. Front Street, Tyler, Texas, 75702. Comments may also be emailed to carson.hollis@txdot.gov. To be included as part of the project’s official record, comments must be received by Friday, November 17, 2017.
