INTRODUCTION

The purpose of this open house meeting is to present the proposed improvements of FM 2113 in the City of Hewitt. This project is identified as S-PMR-S in the Metropolitan Transportation Plan of the Waco Metropolitan Planning Organization. The purpose of this open house meeting is to present the proposed design and solicit public input.

PROJECT INFORMATION

The schematic and environmental studies for this project extend from FM 2063 (Sun Valley Road) to FM 1695 (Hewitt Drive). The proposed project would widen FM 2113 to include a 14 foot continuous center left turn lane and 10 foot shoulders within the existing right-of-way. Curb and gutter will replace the existing open drainage ditch to accommodate the additional pavement width. Access to adjacent local streets and properties would be maintained. The project will not require additional right-of-way or easements.
