



Notice of Public Meeting
FM 2113
From FM 2063 (Sun Valley Drive) to FM 1695 (Hewitt Drive)

The Texas Department of Transportation (TxDOT) will hold a public meeting regarding the proposed improvements of FM 2113 (Spring Valley Road) through the city of Hewitt, Texas. This project would extend from FM 2063 (Sun Valley Drive) to FM 1695 (Hewitt Drive).

TxDOT will present the project information in a come and go format; no formal presentation will be made. The meeting details are as follows.

The existing roadway on FM 2113 consists of two 12 ft travel lanes with shoulders which vary from 1 ft to 8 ft with an open drainage ditch. Center left turn lanes are provided at the intersection of Old Temple Road and Spring Valley Elementary. The proposed project would widen FM 2113 to include 12 ft travel lanes, 14 ft continuous center left turn lane and 10 ft shoulders. The existing open drainage ditch would be replaced with curb and gutter. No additional right-of-way would be required.

Exhibits showing aerial photography and schematic plans of the proposed project corridor will be present at the meeting. Representatives from TxDOT, and its consultant study team will be available to answer individual questions. Public comments are encouraged.

All interested citizens are invited to attend the meeting and discuss the project. The meeting will be conducted in English. TxDOT will make every reasonable effort to accommodate these needs.
