1	Rudy Garza	7/13/2017	Comment received at public meeting	<p>Speed is a big concern - speed limit 50 - vehicles go in excess of 60-70 mph. Very Dangerous!! Across the rd - two homes have child 3-6 years old. I35 traffic is another concern - excessive traffic when I35 is congested.</p> <p>Biggest concern is speed needs to be reduced.</p> <p>Addition: my neighbor's home was hit by a distracted driver - about 1/2 mile house on the opposite side of the rd was also hit.</p>	<p>Once the project is completed, TxDOT may request that a speed study be performed on the roadway. The speed study will determine what the speed of the 85th percentile speed of the study data (drivers) is and this is how the speed limit is set. This represents the speed the majority of drivers will be traveling at or below. To ensure a true reflection of a normal traffic situation, speed checks are made on average weekdays during off-peak hours, under favorable weather conditions. The data collected typically shows roadway features such as curves, surface width and type, right-of-way width, crash history, cross streets, school crossings and sites that generate traffic.</p> <p>The posted limit may be lowered up to 10 mph below the 85th percentile speed if some of the following conditions are present:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Roadway pavement width of 20 feet or less 2. Curves and hills 3. Hidden driveways and other developments 4. High number of driveways 5. Crash history 6. Rural residential or developed area 7. Lack of striped, improved shoulders <p>Once the study is completed, black on white speed limit signs are posted along the roadway to alert drivers of the maximum legal speed for that section of roadway.</p>

People normally travel 60-65 through that street only slow down when they are being watched by police officers.</p> <p>My house has been driven through due to the speed that is allowed in that area. You need to make access to I35 easier for those larger traveling vehicles, easier access than driving down Spring Valley to the new overpass at Sun Valley. There needs to be a NO THRU TRUCK sign posted on this road. Speed limit needs to be lower around school area and past curve in road. Tractor-trailer speed past homes faster than posted 50 mph. School zone is 35 mph and cars/trucks speed. REsidents turning onto streets and pulling out is next to impossible at peak times.	- Due to superelevation at this location, there is a proposed drop inlet near the intersection of Sierra Slope and FM 2113. The tie conditions will cause a small ditch to be implemented into the drainage design. The ditch is taking the water from much of the empty land towards the school and into the proposed drop inlet. - Current plans do not include any traffic signal work at or near the school. Traffic turning coming out of the school is in conflict with traffic on 2113 heading north turning left into the school. The entrance and exit to the school needs more separation so that everybody is not crashing in the turn lane. Also, the right turn lane at the Valero and at the school heading south bound need more signage or delineation because people don't realize that it is terminating until the very last minute, and they cut odd other drivers.	- Roadway geometry, including driveways, is currently being analyzed to determine the most feasible solution within the parameters of the project. - Signage for the FM 2113 is currently being designed. Although right turn lane in front of the Valero is outside the project limits, consideration will be given to adding a "LANE ENDS MERGE LEFT" sign and adding a "RIGHT LANE MUST TURN RIGHT" at the school entrance.

This highway is of significant importance to Hewitt and our residents. The proposed project is greatly needed and as proposed will better facilitate the traffic volume we are experiencing. I concur with the proposed road profile throughout this corridor as shown on drawings I have been provided. We do have a few specific concerns about the overall plans. Without sidewalks, pedestrian access would be severely impaired in this area. Moreover, near Spring Valley Elementary, I believe more attention should be given to providing a more visible and secure pedestrian crossing primarily for the students attending this school. We do believe the widening of the bridge between Chapparral Road and Tillamook Drive would serve to allow a continuous middle turn lane that would effectively mitigate potential vehicular traffic conflicts. We have also identified various storm drainage issues that will need to be addressed at the appropriate time. Of course, the City of Hewitt looks forward to working with TXDOT Officials concerning further planning of this highway segment. Thank you again for the opportunity to comment on this much needed highway improvement. Texas Department of Transportation (TxDOT) will host an open house public meeting to present the proposed plans to make improvements to FM 2113.


WHEN: Tuesday, June 20, 2017

All interested persons are invited to attend this meeting and express their views on the highway project. The project begins at the FM 2063 (Sun Valley Road) and extends approximately 2.5 miles to FM 1695 (Hewitt Drive). The project includes:

- Reconstruct and widen from 2 lanes to 2 lanes with continuous center left turn lane
- Replace open drainage ditch with curb and gutter.



Persons interested in attending this meeting who have special communication or accommodation needs are encouraged to contact David Jayroe, Environmental Specialist, at 254-867-2744, at least three days prior to the open house public meeting. Since the public hearing will be conducted in English, requests for language interpreters or other special communication needs should also be made at least three days prior to the open house public meeting. 

We had a meeting with the MPO today to discuss the City of Hewitt's concerns/suggestions with the FM 2113 project.

Concerns/Suggestions

- No-Thru Trucks allowed
 - Wanted, but will it be enforced?
 - Can we even do this? (City of Nolensville tried and it was rejected)
 - Traffic Engineer at TxDOT will look into this (Jacob Chau)
 - Wants speed study done
 - Jacob can coordinate that also
- Castleman Creek Bridge
 - City wants this bridge widened w/ Sidewalks (City wants sidewalks on both sides of road including bridge)
 - Possibly Cat 2 funding (but we are looking at 10-12 years away)
- Drainage
 - Structure at 140+40 is believed to be undersized currently (I looked after the meeting and this structure's capacity has been increase)
 - Difficult to get water to drain at culvert 222+12
 - TxDOT needs the City to improve upstream and downstream of the channels, and we may need to collect data to improve the models





The proposed project is greatly needed and as proposed will better facilitate the traffic volume we are experiencing. I concur with the proposed road profile throughout this corridor as shown on drawings I have been provided.



FM 2113 Proposed Typical Section






Existing Typical Sections

FM 2113 at Castleman Creek and Chambers Creek




FM 2113 at Old Temple Road




Existing Typical Sections







Description of Project Modifications Resulting From Public Meeting

Since the public meeting on Tuesday, July 13, 2017 the following project modifications have been added to the scope of work:

1. Driveway survey for approximately 56 driveways required to design new driveway profiles that tie into proposed roadway elevations.
2. Bridge at Castleman Creek will be widened to accommodate the proposed typical section.
3. Scour analysis at Castleman Creek bridge due to widening.
4. TxDOT traffic engineers will be looking into the addition of "NO THRU TRUCKS" signs.
5. Proposed driveway at Sta. 161+80 (left side) will be removed from plans as this was a temporary driveway and is no longer required.
6. Driveway at Sta. 137+50 will be removed from proposed improvements as this driveway permit was previously denied by TxDOT.
