Construction is planned to start in spring 2019 to improve safety and mobility on I-35 in Waco.

IMPROVEMENTS INCLUDE – I-35 from 12th Street to N. Loop 340

- Widening mainlanes – 4 lanes in each direction
- Improving frontage roads and ramps
- Reconstructing bridges and improving interchanges
- Adding U-turns
- Improving bicycle and pedestrian access

This construction project is complex considering the significant amount of daily traffic through the core of Waco. We will be working hard to get this job done safely and efficiently while being considerate of the impacts and inconvenience of construction.

We are committed to closely communicating with the community and travelers on I-35 to get you the information you need. Our team is available and encourages you to reach out and stay updated.

PUBLIC OPEN HOUSE


