Moving the ramp and associated denial of access away from her property would impact adjacent properties.</p> <p>Solutions discussed: Damages to property from Denial of Access could provide funds to complete driveway turn around (loop) on her property using the remaining driveway.</p> <p>Add additional auxiliary lanes to off ramp and extend to next on ramp combined with second driveway curb design to permit exit only use.</p> <p>Add additional auxiliary lanes to off ramp and extend to next on ramp combined with a raised median/curb that prevents access to the driveway that was eliminated. This should shorten the denial of access and allow the driveway that was removed.</p> <p>Current design is moving away from short curb radius to a wider driveway radius.</p> <p>The fire hydrant would be relocated in necessary during utility adjustments.</p> <p>If the mailbox is located within the existing right-of-way then it would be relocated in this case behind the 6 feet sidewalk.</p> <p>If needed, the sewer line would be moved during utility adjustments.</p> <p>No raised medians are proposed along the ramp.</p> <p>Retaining walls are needed to accommodate grade differences between the frontage road/mainlanes and the ramp and to allow for a drainage ditches between roadways.</p> |

The Texas Department of Transportation (TxDOT) is proposing to widen Loop (LP) 340 from Brazos River to United States (US) 84 (Bellmead Drive) in McLennan County, Texas. Pursuant to Texas Administrative Code, Title 43, Part 1, Chapter 2, Subchapter E, §2.107 and Code of Federal Regulations, Title 23, Chapter I, Subchapter H, §771.111 and Title 40, Chapter V, §1506, this notice advises the public that TxDOT will be conducting a public meeting to discuss and receive public comments on the proposed project. **The meeting will be held on Thursday, August 24, 2017, at the Bellmead Community Center, 3900 Parrish Dr, Bellmead, Texas, 76705.** Representatives from TxDOT and project consultants will be available to answer questions about the proposed project improvements. **The public meeting will be held in an open house format from 6:00 p.m. to 8:00 p.m., and will include a brief project overview presentation beginning at 6:00 p.m.**

Proposed improvements to LP 340 would include reconstructing and widening this highway from the Brazos River to US 84 in the cities of Bellmead and Waco; a distance of approximately 5.2 miles. The existing LP 340 roadway consists of two 12-foot wide lanes with 10-foot inside and outside shoulders. The proposed project would add one mainlane in each direction and frontage roads. The mainlanes would consist of two 12-foot lanes in each direction with 10-foot outside shoulders and inside shoulders which vary in width separated by a depressed grassy median or concrete traffic barrier. Frontage roads would consist of two 12-foot wide travel lanes, flanked by a 6-foot wide sidewalk. The mainlanes and frontage roads would be separated by a grassy median that varies in width. Frontage road bridges would be constructed over the Brazos River along with mainlanes bridges carrying LP 340 over the existing SP 484 / SH 6 bridges. Additional right-of-way is not anticipated.

Maps that will be displayed at the meeting depicting the location of proposed improvements and the geometric design are on file and available for inspection Monday through Friday between the hours of 8:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. at the TxDOT Waco District Office, 100 South Loop Drive, Waco, TX 76704 and the TxDOT McLennan Area Office, 7479 Bagby Ave. Waco, TX, 76712. This information will be available online at <http://www.txdot.gov/inside-txdot/get-involved.html> under **Hearing & Meetings Schedule**. Project schematics will be available online beginning August 24. Written comments from the public regarding the project are requested and may be presented at the meeting, or submitted in person or by mail to Mr. Andrew Haferkamp, P.E., LP 340 Project Manager, TxDOT Waco District Office 100 South Loop Drive, Waco, TX 76704. **Written comments must be received or postmarked on or before Friday, September 8, 2017 to be included in the documentation of the public meeting.**

The public meeting will be conducted in English. Persons interested in attending the meeting who have special communication or accommodation needs, such as the need for an interpreter, are encouraged to contact the TxDOT Waco District Environmental Specialist David Jayroe at 254-867-2744. Requests should be made at least two days prior to the meeting. Every reasonable effort will be made to accommodate these needs.



The Texas Department of Transportation (TxDOT) is proposing to widen Loop (LP) 340 from Brazos River to United States (US) 84 (Bellmead Drive) in McLennan County, Texas. Pursuant to Texas Administrative Code, Title 43, Part 1, Chapter 2, Subchapter E, §2.107 and Code of Federal Regulations, Title 23, Chapter 1, Subchapter H, §771.111 and Title 40, Chapter V, §1506, this notice advises the public that TxDOT will be conducting a public meeting to discuss and receive public comments on the proposed project. The meeting will be held on Thursday, August 24, 2017, at the Bellmead Community Center, 3900 Parrish Dr., Bellmead, Texas, 76705. Representatives from TxDOT and project consultants will be available to answer questions about the proposed project improvements. The public meeting will be held in an open house format from 6:00 p.m. to 8:00 p.m., and will include a brief project overview presentation beginning at 6:00 p.m.

Proposed improvements to LP 340 would include reconstructing and widening this highway from the Brazos River to US 84 in the cities of Bellmead and Waco; a distance of approximately 5.2 miles. The existing LP 340 roadway consists of two 12-foot wide lanes with 10-foot inside and outside shoulders. The proposed project would add one mainlane in each direction and frontage roads. The mainlanes would consist of two 12-foot lanes in each direction with 10-foot outside shoulders and inside shoulders which vary in width separated by a depressed grassy median or concrete traffic barrier. Frontage roads would consist of two 12-foot wide travel lanes, flanked by a 6-foot wide sidewalk. The mainlanes and frontage roads would be separated by a grassy median that varies in width. Frontage road bridges would be constructed over the Brazos River along with mainlanes bridges carrying LP 340 over the existing SP 484 / SH 6 bridges. Additional right-of-way is not anticipated.


SCHMATIC LAYOUT OF PROPOSED STATE HIGHWAY IMPROVEMENT


SCHEMATIC LAYOUT OF PROPOSED STATE HIGHWAY IMPROVEMENT



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



Vic Goebel, Brian Lamb, Andy Haferkamp and David Jayroe met with Ms. Fisher and Ms. Berry to discuss the proposed LP 340 project. Ms. Fisher and Ms. Berry reside adjacent to LP 340 in the vicinity of Orchard Ln.

Concerns: Why can you not move the off ramp in front of her property to avoid taking one of her two driveways to her house.

TxDOT Response: The denial of access associated with on – off ramps have certain design criteria which must be met. Moving the ramp and associated denial of access away from her property would impact properties adjacent to hers.

Solutions discussed:

1. Damages to property from Denial of Access could provide funds to complete driveway turn around (loop) on her property using the remaining driveway.
2. Add additional auxiliary lanes to off ramp and extend to next on ramp combined with second driveway curb design to permit exit only use.
3. Add additional auxiliary lanes to off ramp and extend to next on ramp combined with a raised median/curb that prevents access to the driveway that was eliminated. This should shorten the denial of access and allow the driveway that was removed.

Concern: Do not like the short radius on driveway curb

TxDOT Response: Current design is moving away from short curb radius to a wider driveway radius.

Concern: What would happen to Fire Hydrant (She paid for)

TxDOT Response: The fire hydrant would be relocated in necessary during utility adjustments.

Concern: Location of mailbox

TxDOT Response: If it is located within the existing right of way then it would be relocated in this case behind the 6 ' sidewalk.

Concern: Sewer line

TxDOT Response: if need it would be moved during utility adjustments.


LOOP 340 - PROPOSED SECTIONS

FROM SOUTH OF BRAZOS RIVER TO US 84





Pursuant to Texas Administrative Code, Title 43, Part 1, Chapter 2, Subchapter E, §2.107 and Code of Federal Regulations, Title 23, Chapter I, Subchapter H, §771.111 and Title 40, Chapter V, §1506, this notice advises the public that TxDOT will be conducting a public meeting to discuss and receive public comments on the proposed project. **The meeting will be held on Thursday, August 24, 2017, at the Bellmead Community Center, 3900 Parrish Dr, Bellmead, Texas, 76705.** Representatives from TxDOT and project consultants will be available to answer questions about the proposed project improvements. **The public meeting will be held in an open house format from 6:00 p.m. to 8:00 p.m., and will include a brief project overview presentation beginning at 6:00 p.m.**


Proposed improvements to LP 340 would include reconstructing and widening this highway from the Brazos River to US 84 in the cities of Bellmead and Waco; a distance of approximately 5.2 miles. The existing LP 340 roadway consists of two 12-foot wide lanes with 10-foot inside and outside shoulders. The proposed project would add one mainlane in each direction and frontage roads. The mainlanes would consist of two 12-foot lanes in each direction with 10-foot outside shoulders and inside shoulders which vary in width separated by a depressed grassy median or concrete traffic barrier. Frontage roads would consist of two 12-foot wide travel lanes, flanked by a 6-foot wide sidewalk. The mainlanes and frontage roads would be separated by a grassy median that varies in width. Frontage road bridges would be constructed over the Brazos River along with mainlanes bridges carrying LP 340 over the existing SP 484 / SH 6 bridges. Additional right-of-way is not anticipated.

Maps that will be displayed at the meeting depicting the location of proposed improvements and the geometric design are on file and available for inspection Monday through Friday between the hours of 8:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. at the TxDOT Waco District Office, 100 South Loop Drive, Waco, TX 76704 and the TxDOT McLennan Area Office, 7479 Bagby Ave. Waco, TX, 76712. Project schematics will be available online beginning August 24.
