INTRODUCTION

The purpose of this open house meeting is to present the proposed expansion of US 190 through the city limits of Harker Heights, Nolanville and Belton, Texas. This project is identified as W40-06 in the Metropolitan Transportation Plan of the Killeen Temple Metropolitan Planning Organization (http://www.ktmpo.org/wp-content/uploads/2013/03/Project-Listing_Reprioritization-Projects_12.16.2016.pdf). The purpose of this open house meeting is to present the proposed design and solicit public input.

PROJECT INFORMATION

The schematic and environmental studies for this project extend from one mile west of FM 2410 (Knights Way) to FM 2410 (Simmons Rd.). The proposed project would widen US 190 from four to six lanes by adding a third travel lane (eastbound and westbound) in the existing median. The locations of entrance and exit ramps would also be modified throughout. No additional right-of-way would be required.

Currently, construction funding is not available for the entire length of this project; however, a construction project (CSJ: 0231-03-143) that would extend from 1 mile west of FM 2410 to FM 3423 (Indian Trail) is funded via Proposition 7, and is scheduled for contract bidding in June 2017.
