



NOTICE OF PUBLIC MEETING
US 190 from FM 2410 (west) to FM 2410 (east)

The Texas Department of Transportation (TxDOT) will hold a public meeting regarding the proposed expansion of US 190 through the cities of Harker Heights, Nolanville and Belton, Texas. This project would extend from FM 2410 (near Forest Hills Dr.) to FM 2410 (Simmons Rd.).

TxDOT will present the project information in a come and go format; no formal presentation will be made. The meeting details are as follows:

The proposed project would widen US 190 from four to six lanes by adding the third lane of through traffic in the existing median. Entrance and exit ramps would also be adjusted. No additional right-of-way would be required.

Exhibits showing aerial photography and schematic plans of the proposed project corridor will be present at the meeting. Representatives from TxDOT, and its consultant study team will be available to answer individual questions. Public comments are encouraged.

All interested citizens are invited to attend and discuss the project. The meeting will be conducted in English. TxDOT will make every reasonable effort to accommodate these needs.

Information about the proposed project is on file and available for inspection Monday through Friday between the hours of 8:00 a.m. and 5:00 p.m. at 100 South Loop Drive, Waco, TX. TxDOT offices are open Monday through Friday, from 8:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m., excluding state holidays.
