We have been told the TxDOT expansion would go no further/under than the new access roads constructed 4/5 years ago. We have a number of promising and interested parties to buy. This new development will shoot these sales down. The interested people actually wanted slightly more acreage than we have. If you take this acreage you seek my remaining property value will diminish! This will make the remaining smaller acreage less attractive and much harder to sell.	The new frontage road proposed by this project would enhance the local access. Any right-of-way acquisition by TxDOT would be in accordance with the U.S. Department of Transportation policy as mandated by the Uniform Relocation Assistance and Real Property Acquisition Policies Act of 1970, as amended in the Surface Transportation and Uniform Relocation Assistance Act of 1987 (the Uniform Act).
7a					The following comments are offered by David Cryan and Mike Weber, [REDACTED]. Mr. Cryan is the owner of 62.5 acres of property located between Allen's Creek and Rexville Road on the north side of and fronting on I-10. Mr. Cryan is also the donor of the 6.563 acres of land which provides the ROW for the frontage road from Allen's Creek to Rexville Road. Both parties have a financial interest in the project as business property owners and could benefit monetarily from the project. Mr. Cryan could also be negatively impacted by the project. Mr. Cryan has paid the City of Sealy approximately \$1.9 million dollars to complete the existing frontage road bordering the owned property on the south side as part of the remittance by the City to TxDOT for the costs of the frontage road. Both parties are in favor of the project due to the economic benefit to the City of Sealy and the improvement of current traffic conditions on Interstate 10. If the results of this noise study determines that proposed noise barriers would be reasonable and feasible at the location where your property is located, a noise workshop would be held to request comments from property owners adjacent to where the noise barrier would be proposed.

Please confirm the validity of these access points relative to the revised plan.	The six access points granted by the separate frontage road project that is currently under construction would remain.

Is there the potential that the local entities would be reimbursed for the portion of the new frontage road retained and used as a part of this project?	The westbound frontage road currently under construction was outlined in an agreement between TxDOT and the City of Sealy. This proposed project (I-10 from FM 3538 to FM 359) would tie in to that westbound frontage road. TxDOT will operate and maintain the frontage road after construction. TxDOT is not reimbursing the City of Sealy for this portion of the new frontage road that is currently in use.

The Texas Department of Transportation (TxDOT) will hold a public meeting regarding the proposed design changes to the Interstate Highway 10 (I-10) Improvement and Reconstruction Project, from Farm-to-Market 3538 (FM 3538) in Sealy, Austin County to Farm-to-Market 359 (FM 359) in Brookshire, Waller County. The meeting will be held on Thursday, August 17, 2017, at the Sealy Junior High School located at 939 Tiger Lane, Sealy, Texas, 77474. The meeting will be held in an open house format from 5:30 p.m. to 7:30 p.m. No formal presentation will be made.


The purpose of the Public Meeting is to present the proposed design changes to the public and receive comments. The proposed project has been revised to include additional frontage roads near the City of Sealy and other design changes to ramps and intersections within Austin County. Design changes also include continuous frontage roads from FM 3538 to SH 36 and a two-way to one-way frontage road conversion from the BNSF Railroad to Ward Bend Road. The proposed design changes would require approximately 7 acres of additional right-of-way.

Maps showing the proposed project's location and design drawings will be available for review at the Public Meeting. Information will also be available for review by appointment Monday through Friday between the hours of 8:00 a.m. and 5:00 p.m., excluding holidays, at the TxDOT Yoakum District Office, located at 403 Huck Street, Yoakum, Texas 77995. 



WASHINGTON — Frustrated over China's inability to pressure North Korea over its nuclear program, the Trump administration is weighing plans to punish China for failing to crack down on intellectual property thefts and forcing U.S. and foreign companies to share their technology in return for access to the vast Chinese market.

That's according to two people familiar with the discussion, who spoke on condition of anonymity because the plans have not been made public.

Possible sanctions

The administration is considering invoking the rarely used Section 301 of the Trade Act of 1974, which empowers Washington to investigate Chinese trade practices and impose sanctions, including tariffs, according to one of those people.

The investigation would focus on China's alleged forced technology transfer policies and practices, one of the people said, adding that the Trump administration could move to launch such a probe this week. The second person cautioned that no decisions or timelines had been finalized yet.

U.S. and other Western governments and business groups accuse Beijing of unfairly nurturing Chinese competitors — in fields ranging from medi-

The following comments are offered by David Cryan and Mike Weber, [REDACTED]. Mr. Cryan is the owner of 62.5 acres of property located between Allen's Creek and Rexville Road on the north side of and fronting on I-10. Mr. Cryan is also the donor of the 6.563 acres of land which provides the ROW for the frontage road from Allen's Creek to Rexville Road. Both parties have a financial interest in the project as business property owners and could benefit monetarily from the project. Mr. Cryan could also be negatively impacted by the project. Mr. Cryan has paid the City of Sealy approximately \$1.9 million dollars to complete the existing frontage road bordering the owned property on the south side as part of the remittance by the City to TxDOT for the costs of the frontage road. Both parties are in favor of the project due to the economic benefit to the City of Sealy and the improvement of current traffic conditions on Interstate 10.

Signs change eastbound exit at FM3538 to Include "Rexville Road"

Signs change westbound exit at Rexville Road delete "Kloecker" and add "Town Park Drive"

Signs change exit eastbound at San Felipe and Mlcak add "Blinn College"








