Navarro Street Median Project (BU 77)
From Loop 463 to Airline Road
Victoria County, Texas

The Texas Department of Transportation (TxDOT), Yoakum District, will host an Open House to present the proposed roadway improvements for Navarro Street (BU 77) from Loop 463 to Airline Road in Victoria, Victoria County, Texas. The Open House will be held on Tuesday, August 22 from 4:30 p.m. to 6:30 p.m. in Conference Room D, at the Victoria Fine Arts Center, located at 1002 Sam Houston Drive, Victoria, Texas, 77905.

The purpose of the meeting is to gather public input on the proposed improvements. The public is invited to view project maps, visit with team members, ask questions, and share comments on the proposed project. No formal presentation will be made.

The proposed improvements include constructing approximately 14,000 feet of raised median along Navarro St. and left turn lanes would be constructed in the median at various locations to allow turning movements. The proposed project would improve safety, mobility, and reduce crashes along this section of roadway.
