The purpose of these meetings is to receive comments on the FY 2019 - 2022 Rural Transportation Improvement Program (Rural TIP) for the Yoakum District. The District includes Austin, Colorado, Calhoun, DeWitt, Fayette, Gonzales, Jackson, Lavaca, Matagorda, Victoria, and Wharton Counties. The Rural TIP is a mechanism used by TxDOT and FHWA to fund projects for the next four years and includes all federally funded projects. This meeting is being held pursuant to Title 43, Texas Administrative Code, Section 16.102, which calls for an opportunity for public comment concerning the program.
