

- Provide added capacity for projected traffic





SH 72 PROPOSED TYPICAL SECTION
 (CITY OF CUERO)

Proposed Improvements

- Reconstruct SH 72 from 2 lanes to 4 lanes
- Add a 4-foot flush median between oncoming lanes in the rural section
- Add 10-foot shoulders
- Additional turn lanes on SH 72 at US 87 in Cuero, Blackwell Lane/Bell Road, and FM 237
- Improve safety of curves
- Approximately 50 acres of right of way (ROW) would be required
- No additional ROW required east of Douglas Street in Cuero
- No work will be done on the Guadalupe bridge crossing
