We feel it is a major waste of funds for the following reasons:</p> <p>1- Oilfield traffic has tremendously decreased. I was told the traffic count being used is from during the boom which is no longer applicable. I drive to Yorktown 3 to 4 times weekly and there is no traffic flow problem.</p> <p>2- Why is what used to be a farm-to-market road being turned into a 4 lane state highway when 2 lanes are sufficient on U.S. Highway 87? Sh 72 will never be an evacuation route because of river flooding. It seems funds would be better spent turning US 87 into 4 lanes.</p> <p>3- Most oil pools in this part of DeWitt County are drilled to capacity with some companies drilling sharing wells to make ne wells fit. The major oil activity is now in for west Texas and Karnes County. Yet SH 72 in Karnes County is not being increased to 4 lanes. Considering the price of oil the increased expense of developing the next deeper formation – another oil boom any time soon is unlikely.</p> <p>4- The speed limit on this stretch of SH 72 west has long been a problem, especially for the 18 wheelers. 



Residents invited to test their smarts at Knowledge Bowl

In 1976, what company operated the largest milk plant in Texas?

If the answer to this trivia question quickly comes to mind, you should consider competing in the 26th annual Knowledge Bowl, hosted by the Victoria Adult Literacy Council.

The competitive event will be 5-9 p.m. Feb. 22 at the Victoria College Student Center, 2200 E. Red River St.

Teams should register right away and pay a \$100 entry fee. Spectators are encouraged to attend the event for \$5.

While the fun event puts local competitors to the test, it also raises much-needed funds for the Victoria Adult Literacy Council, said Executive Director Stacey Milberger.

"Right now funds are tight and people are still trying to recover from the hurricane, so community giving is down," she said. "The funds

raised at the event will go to make sure that our doors stay open and our services aren't interrupted."

She hopes to raise \$20,000 this year. Sponsorships are still available.

Ever since 1986, the council has provided free literacy instruction and community outreach to improve the workforce and raise the quality of life in the Victoria area. This means recruiting, training, and supporting volunteer tutors who teach literacy skills to those with learning disabilities as well as work on "English as a Second Language" literacy with adult students.

The council also provides GED support and family literacy in practice classes at an educational facility at Creekstone Ranch Apartments.

Milberger said this facility allows them to offer many types of classes, including summer reading programs. More than 100 people have received services in the past eight months since the

facility opened.

"All services are free," she said, adding that a tutor is working with English as a Second Language students in a computer science course at Victoria College.

Milberger said every year she tells the teams that being educated is learning something new every day and that if the only thing that happens is students understand more than what they came knowing, then their goal has been achieved.






Rural Existing & Proposed Typical Section







J. Design Changes

J1. Summary of Design Changes

SH 72 Alternative Analysis Methodology

Universe of Alternatives/Preliminary Alternatives

1. No-build

- a. The existing alignment and roadway width stays the same and no improvements are proposed.

2. Alternative 1

- a. The existing alignment stays in place and the roadway is widened to 14 feet on both sides with a 4 foot flush median. The roadway width is widened from 40 feet to 72 feet. The right of way (ROW) width is widened from 100 feet to 140 feet.

3. Alternative 2

- a. The existing alignment is shifted to the east and the pavement is widened to the east by 32 feet. The ROW width is widened from 100 feet to 140 feet, and the additional 40 feet to be acquired is proposed on the east side.

4. Alternative 3

- a. The existing alignment is shifted to the west and the pavement is widened to the west by 32 feet. The ROW width is widened from 100 feet to 140 feet, and the additional 40 feet to be acquired is proposed on the west side.

Alternatives Eliminated From Further Consideration

1. Alternative 2 and Alternative 3

Preferred Alternative (Alternative1) Modifications

1. Alternative 1a

- a. This modification would straightened out or flatten the “S” curve between Station 25+00 and Station 45+00. The modification would allow the horizontal alignment to meet a 70 mph design speed. This location is just west of the City of Cuero. This modification would necessitate acquiring additional ROW beyond the additional ROW for Alternative 1 south of the existing alignment.
- b. Ultimately TxDOT decided to keep the existing alignment between Station 25+00 and Station 45+00.
- c. Alternative 1a was eliminated from further consideration

2. Alternative 1b

- a. This modification would allow for the alignment at the intersection at SH 72 at US 87 to be straightened out to be more of a 90 degree intersection configuration. However this would essentially relocate SH 72 from Station 155+00 to Station 210+00.00.
- b. This modification was eliminated do to the relocation of the roadway, the number of displacements that would be needed, and the additional ROW that would need to be acquired.

3. Alternative 1c

- a. This modification would straighten out or flatten out the “S” curve between Station 711+00 and Station 760+00. The modification would allow the horizontal alignment to meet a 70 mph design speed. This location is just northeast of the City of Yorktown. This modification would necessitate acquiring additional ROW beyond the additional ROW for Alternative 1 south of the existing alignment.
- b. TxDOT requested a modification to Alternative 1c. TxDOT asked that the existing ROW line, and the pavement edge on the north side of SH 72 be held and the alignment be flattened or straightened out to meet a 70 mph design speed. This modification would necessitate ROW to be acquired mostly on the south side of SH 72. Alternative 1c configuration was incorporated into Preferred Alternative 1.

Preferred Alternative (Alternative1) Modifications After Public Meeting

1. Alternative 1d

- a. This modification would straighten out or flatten the “S” curve between Station 88+50 and Station 101+20. This location is just west of the City of Cuero. This modification would necessitate acquiring additional ROW beyond the additional 140-foot total ROW for Alternative 1 south of the existing alignment.
- b. This modification was the result of comments gathered from residents in proximity of this location. The comments received suggested widening the roadway on the south side of the roadway and away from existing homes on the north side of the roadway. In order to accomplish this modification, the existing edge of pavement on the north side of the road was held in its present location. Then the roadway centerline was shifted to the south and the horizontal curve was flattened.
