Why are frontage roads needed on US 59?

Currently the majority of US 59 in Wharton County is not a controlled access, expressway-type road. As traffic increases in the area, accessing the mainlanes of US 59 becomes more difficult. TxDOT is currently studying controlling the access along the US 59 mainlanes and providing frontage roads, so US 59 in Wharton County can be safer, and better accommodate growing traffic volumes.

Project Purpose

The purpose of the US 59 project through Wharton County is to provide frontage roads and convert the existing lanes of US 59 to a

controlled access, expressway-type road that meets Interstate standards.


Project Need


