

I-35 AT WESTINGHOUSE ROAD ROAD FACT SHEET

Why improvements are needed

I-35 through Williamson County is one of the most congested highways in Texas. It serves as the backbone of the local, regional and national transportation network. Lack of mobility on I-35 threatens the economic livelihood of our city and our state.

Improvements to this area are needed to increase visibility at the I-35 frontage road and Westinghouse Road. These improvements will enhance safety and mobility by reducing potential crash points at intersections and by allowing more cars to more through an intersection.

Project Purpose

The purpose of the project is to improve safety and mobility at the I-35 and Westinghouse Road intersection by:

- Demolish the Westinghouse Road bridge and construct a new I-35 bridge over Westinghouse Road
- Construct a westbound to southbound Continuous Flow Intersection (CFI) at Westinghouse Road
- Improve bicycle and pedestrian sidewalks and paths



Details and Timeline

The environmental study will begin in late 2020 and will incorporate input collected at upcoming public involvement meetings. The environmental study and schematic design are anticipated to be complete in mid-2023. Construction is anticipated to begin mid-2023. All construction dates are contingent on funding.
