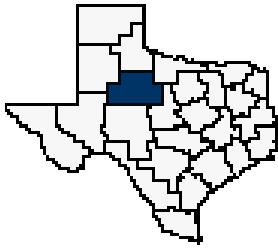




DISTRICT PROFILE

The Abilene District plans, designs, builds, operates and maintains the state transportation system in its 13 counties. The district primarily conducts asset preservation and mobility projects to ensure the safety of the traveling public. The Abilene District experiences generally mild and dry weather conditions, with some extreme temperatures and weather events occurring in summer and winter, which can present challenges for maintenance crews and designers to maintain district assets and assure the safety travelers year-round.

KEY PROJECTS UNDER WAY:

- IH 20 in Nolan County roadway rehabilitation - \$17 million
- FM 700 @ US 87 in Howard County - construct new overpass - \$7.8 million
- SH 350 in Howard County - roadway rehabilitation - \$13.1 million
- US 83 in Taylor County - construction overpass and roadway rehabilitation - \$29 million
- FM 707 Taylor County - roadway widening - \$14 million
- IH 20 Preventative Maintenance and Hazard Elimination in Mitchell County - \$14.7 million.

PLANNED KEY PROJECTS:

- IH 20 And US 84 Interchange in Nolan County - \$70 million
- FM 89 Buffalo Gap Road from Winters Freeway to near Bettles Lane - \$23 million
- US 83 and FM 3034 Interchange - \$15.5 million
- IH 20 Widen Freeway between FM 600 to Loop 322 including overpass at Judge Ely Blvd - \$120 million
- US 83/84 Interchange near Tuscola - \$17 million
- US 83 construct 5 lane highway north of Tuscola - \$15 million
- IH 20 preventative Maintenance - \$18 million/year

MAINTENANCE: Each year, the district spends approximately \$10 million on sealcoating projects and several million dollars rehabilitating I-20 and other major corridors.

CORRIDORS: The district's priority corridors include I-20, the urban portion of US 83/84 through Abilene, US 277, US 87, US 180 and US 84.

SAFETY: The Abilene District's safety program has more than \$27 million budgeted for the next two years, including projects underway for adding concrete traffic barriers, roadway widenings, intersection improvements, and safety treating bridges and fixed objects. Also, the district is upgrading existing lighting systems and has \$6.0 million allocated for striping improvements for fiscal year 2021.
