



Notice of Public Meeting
Rehabilitation of BS 70-G (Lamar St)
Sweetwater, TX

The Texas Department of Transportation will conduct a public meeting Tuesday, July 24, 2012 in the administration classroom at the Rolling Plains Memorial Hospital at 200 E. Arizona Avenue in Sweetwater Texas. The purpose of the meeting is to inform citizens about the impacts of the proposed rehabilitation of Lamar Street from Avenue B to IH 20. The public is invited to view exhibits of the proposed project from 1:00 PM to 8:00 PM. The meeting will be held in an informal, open house format to accommodate as many people as possible. No formal presentation will be given, but members of the Texas Department of Transportation will be available to answer questions and take comments. Comments will also be accepted for ten days after the date of the meeting.

The proposed project will consist of rehabilitating the existing roadway consisting of new flex base, asphalt pavement, sidewalks, signs, and pavement markings. The project will be built in phases with one side of Lamar Street closed at a time. Exhibits available at the meeting will include layouts of the proposed project, environmental documentation, tentative construction schedule and other related information. After the meeting, exhibits will be available at both the Area Office located at 1301 North SH 350 in Big Spring, TX and the Maintenance Office located at 7526 North IH 20 in Sweetwater, TX. Citizens not able to attend the meeting may view the information and make comments for ten days after the meeting.
