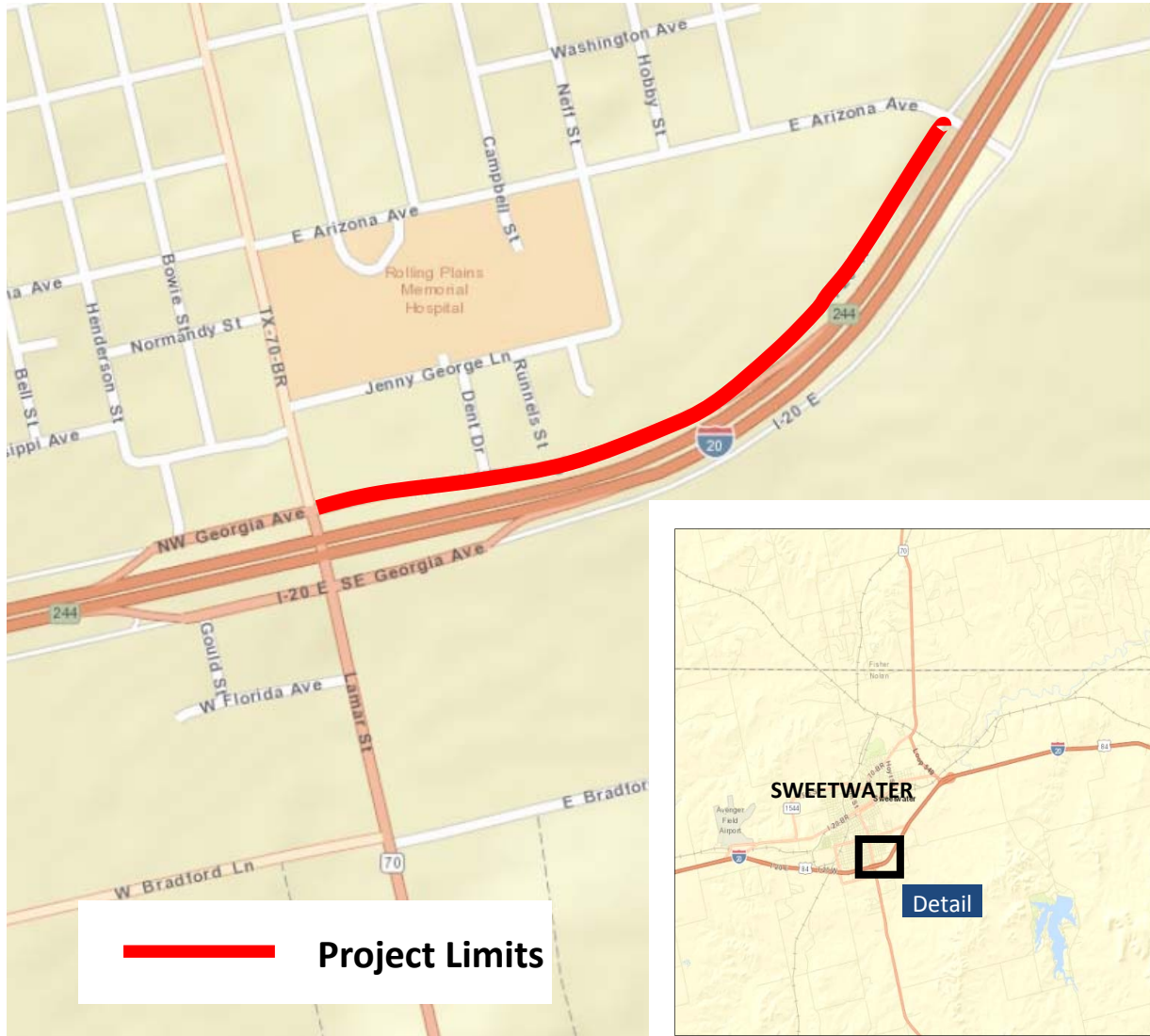


I-20 NORTH FRONTAGE ROAD PROJECT IN SWEETWATER

PROJECT DETAILS

County: Nolan County

Highway/Limits: IH 20 NFR from BS 70 (Lamar St.) to E. Arizona Ave.

Length: 0.62 miles

Cost: \$2,210,945.00

NEED AND PURPOSE

Commercial development has significantly increased in this area of Sweetwater. As a result, the existing roadway has experienced significant rutting, cracking, and deteriorating.

The purpose of this project is to re-habilitate the roadway to provide for the safe and efficient movement of people and goods through Sweetwater.

PLANNED IMPROVEMENTS

The proposed project will consist of rehabilitating and widening the existing roadway to current standards and adding sidewalk for pedestrians.

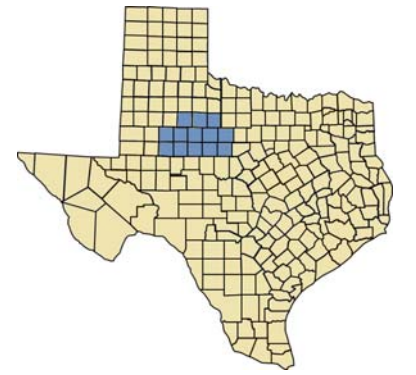
Improvements will include curb & gutter, driveway work, and revegetation of State Right-of-Way.

TRAFFIC CONTROL

The proposed traffic control will temporarily convert the frontage road to one-way during construction. This will decrease the construction duration to approximately five months. More importantly, it will increase safety for the travelling public and contractor.

PROJECT FUNDING

This project is funded with traditional funding allocated to the Abilene TxDOT District.



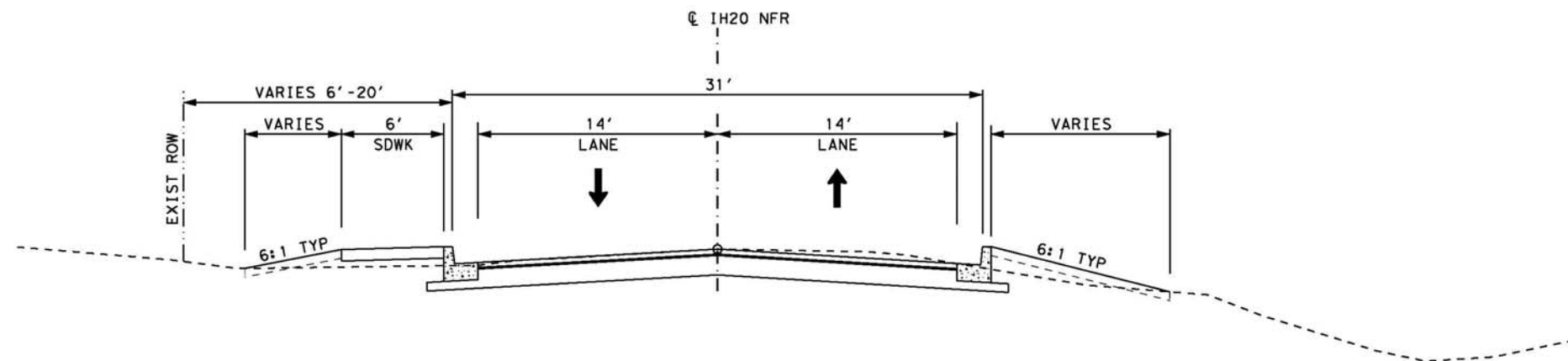
